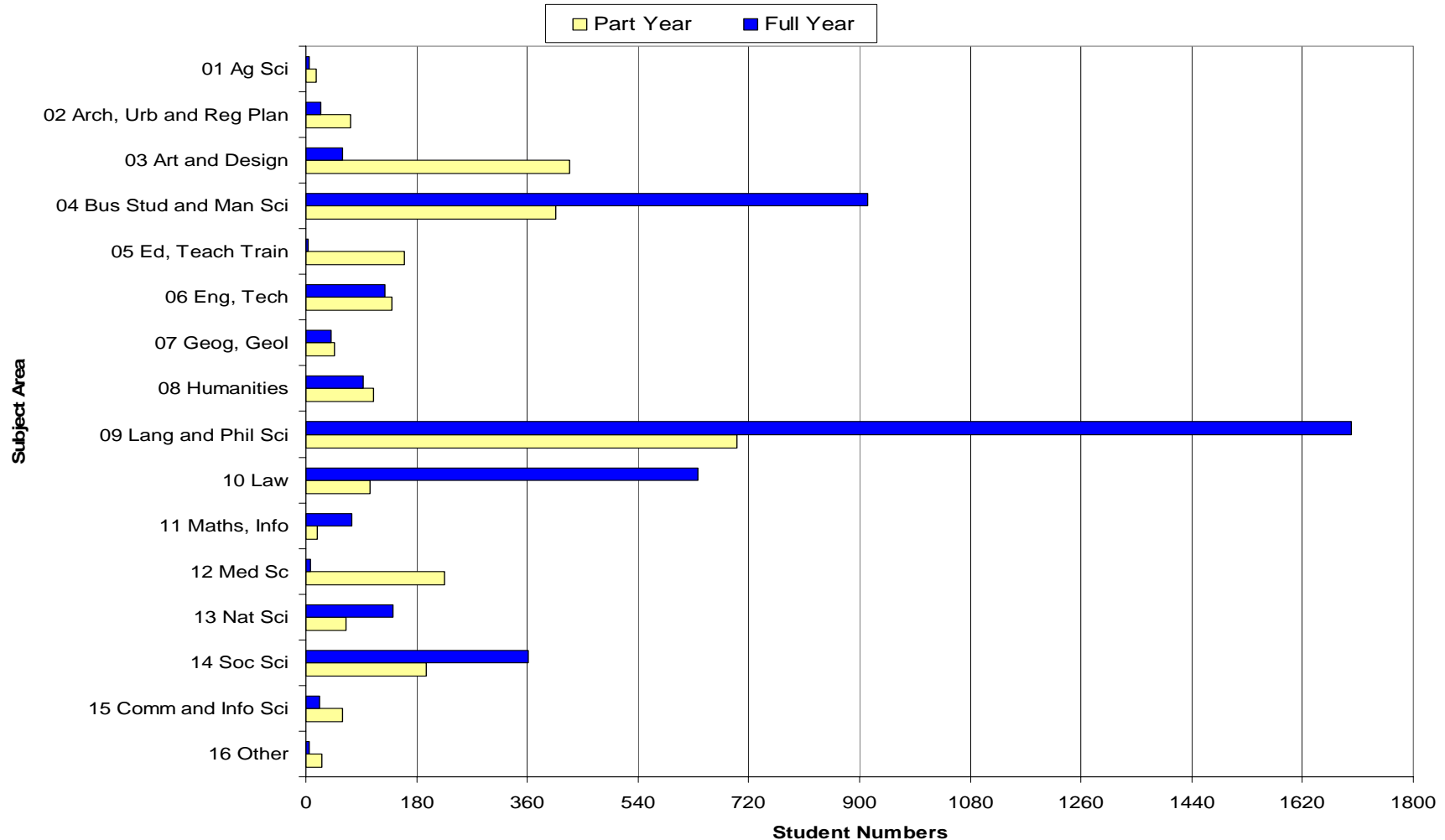

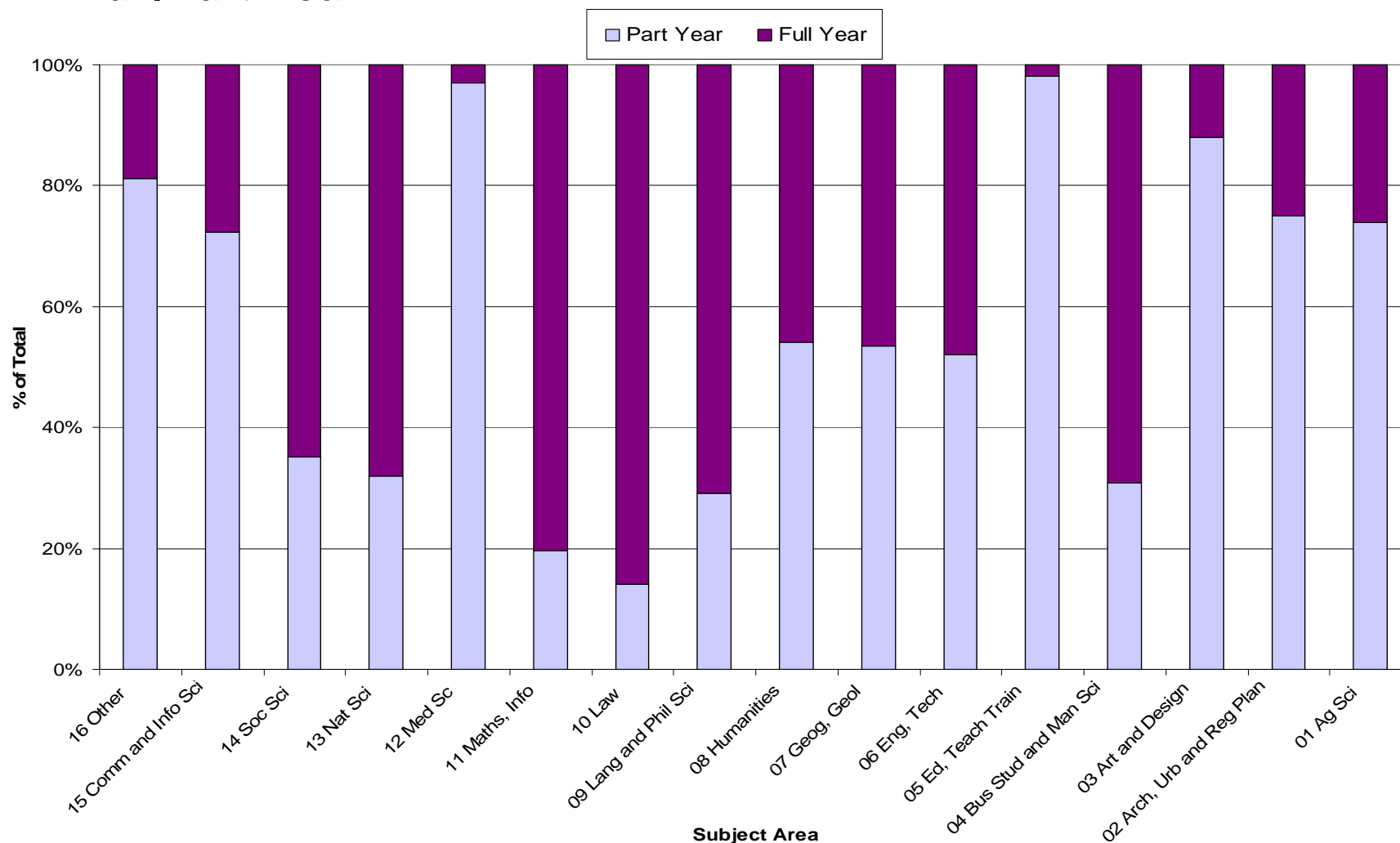

2003/2004: UK Erasmus Students by Subject Area and Full/Part Year



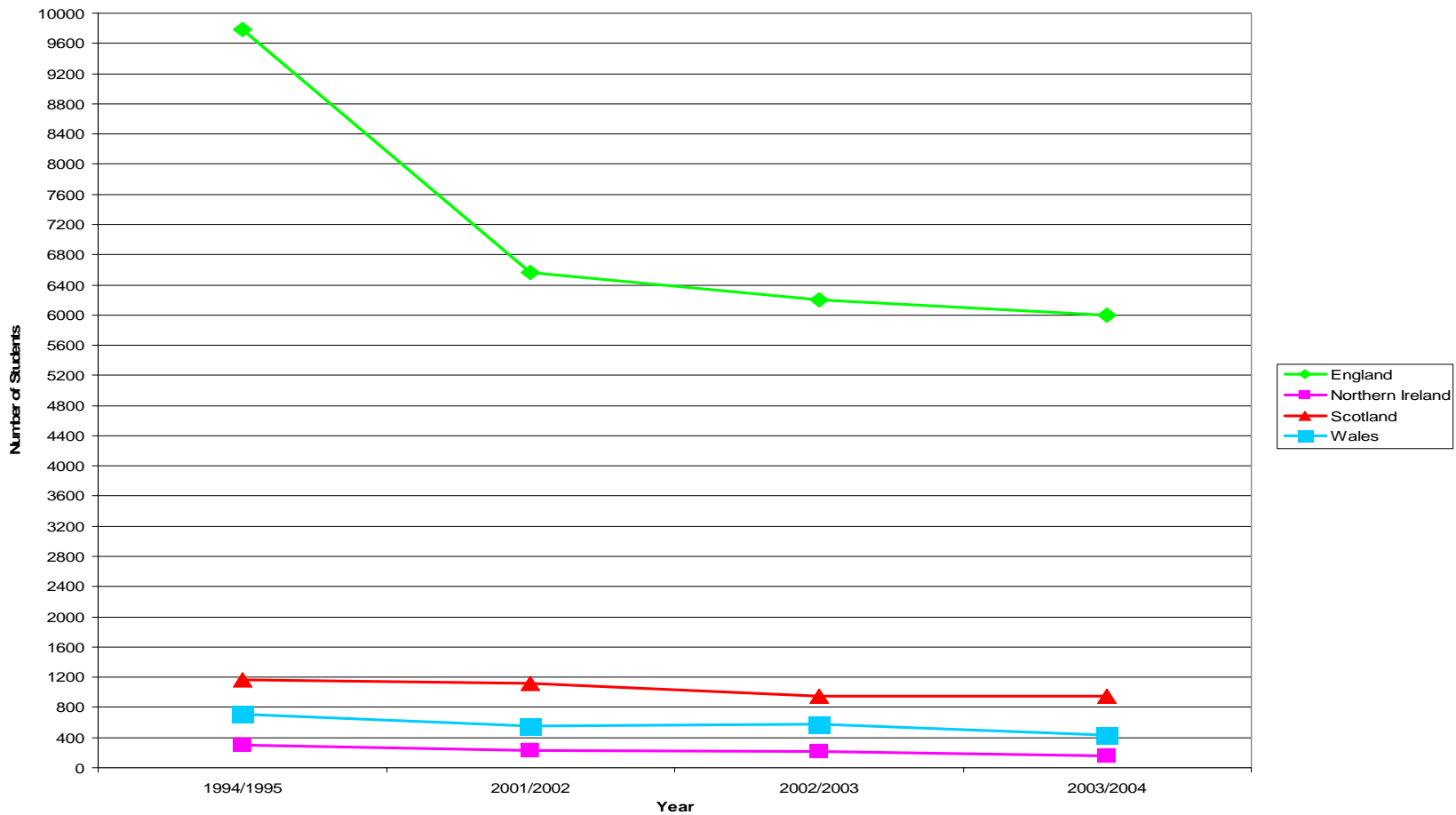
2003/2004: UK Erasmus Students by Subject Area and % of Full/Part Year



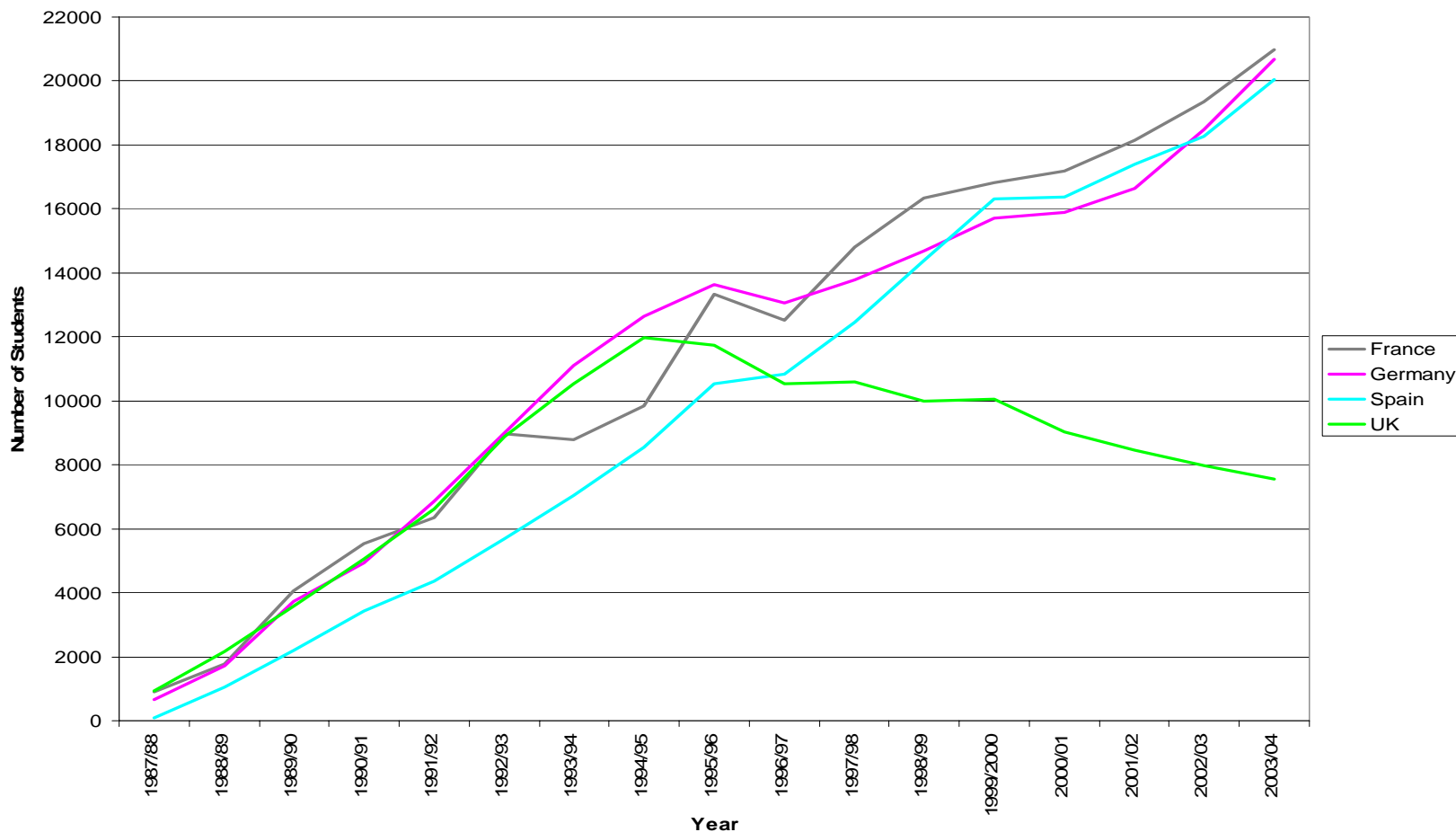
