Joint DDP:

IR Programme University of Kent - HSE

- The MA in International Relations (International Double Award) is an 18-month degree programme, with the 1st year spent at Kent and the 2nd year in Moscow. Successful completion of the programme – which is worth 240 credits [120 ECTS] – leads to the award of the MA in International Relations (International Double Award) from the University of Kent and the Master's Degree from the Higher School of Economics in Moscow.

“Pure” International DDP: Humboldt University Berlin & HSE

- Upon acceptance participants are enrolled, both, at Humboldt University in Berlin and at Higher School of Economics in Moscow. Teaching starts in Moscow at HSE (two semesters), where courses are given in Russian and English. Then students spend two semesters in Berlin, where teaching is in English and German. The programme should be finished, including examination and internship, in four or five semesters.

On successful completion students are awarded the degree ‘Master of Science’ in *Economics and Management Science* from Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin, which is equivalent to the German Diploma. In addition, they obtain the Master’s Degree from the Higher School of Economics according to their specialization.

DDP curricular development: frames and limitations

Effective Russian Federal educational discipline-based standard requirements* for Master’s level programs

Credit transfer requirements:

acceptance of credits earned at other HEIs –

only on a ‘course per course’ basis, incl. course content and workload estimation

No block-course acceptance of credits is currently allowed

- New competence-based federal educational standard allowing more flexibility for modularizing courses and transferring credits by Russian HEIs is to be introduced from 1 September, 2009.
- New HSE’ status opens way for new original programme structures releases from legal Federal Standards frames

DDP curricular development: frames and limitations

U-HSE general Master's program structure (120 credits = 60 credits per annum):

- Core and compulsory subjects – 60 credits, incl.
study courses - 24
research seminars - 6
research practicum - 6
Master's thesis –24 credits
- Elective subjects – 60 credits, among them up to 30 –
from other MA programs of the U-HSE

DDP curricular development: frames and limitations

U-HSE's admission requirements: Documents

Bachelor's level (minimum) diploma recognized by the RF Ministry of Education and Science (as formally required for foreign students)

DDP curricular development: frames and limitations

U-HSE's admission requirements: Entrance examination

Economics:

Higher Mathematics (written)/Economics (written) (for Economics and Mathematical Methods in Economics tracks)

Economics (written)/English (written +auditing) – for other tracks

Sociology:

Sociology (written)/ English (written +auditing) – for all tracks

International Relations:

World History (written)/ English (written +auditing)

Public Law:

Theory of State and Law (oral)

Organization of students' individual educational tracks

- Each student has to formulate his/her 'Individual study plan' (ISP) until September, 21– basing on the information about the Master's programs disciplines and options, advice of his/her scientific adviser and the main principles (no less than 60 credit pointed forms of activity each year, above described proportion between all forms of educational activities etc.)
- If some disciplines could not be taken (elective courses not started, restriction of the number of participants coming from other programs etc.) – possibility to rewrite the ISP until October, 1

Requirements for including elective courses and research seminars into curriculum

- No less than 8-10 students have chosen the program
- No less than 5 students have chosen the research seminar
- No more than 25 students can be allowed to attend an elective course resp. research seminar
- Priority – for students of the same Master program, with higher entry scores etc.

Challenges and Opportunities Strategy of HSE internationalization till 2020

- No Federal Standard Legal Restrictions
- Number of Programmes and Courses delivered in English
- Achieving balanced and increased attendance of international programmes
- Development of interdisciplinary programmes
- Joint int. study groups
- QA and international staff recruitment
- SRS = > CIE
