Implementation Ba-Ma structure in Flanders

Ba-Ma gradually introduced in 2004-2005
in all HEI in Flanders (new educational legislation)

2006/2007: first Bachelor degrees awarded

2007/2008: Master degrees offered

Flanders Educational System

- Old system:
 1. 'kandidatuur' : 2 years
 2. 'licentiaat' : 2 years
 pharmacy, engineering, law,... : 3 years
 3. medicine : 7 years
- BA : 180 cts
- MA : 60 cts – 120 cts – 240 cts

UNIVERSITY OF ANTWERP ERASMUS BUDGET

- 2007/2008 : 213 students go abroad for 'study periods'
- allocated budget: 174.000 €, based on past performance
- calculation leads to an expenditure of 190.000 €
- > if not sufficient : reduce grant accordingly or university pays the difference ???



University fund for Internationalisation and International Mobility

- policy paper 'The BaMa structure and the internationalisation' (2002)
- UA-action plan 'The international dimension in the BaMa' (2003)
- Educational Development Plan (2004)



Travel grants for students:

- Exchange **outside Europe** :500 € - 250 €
- North-South co-operation:750 € - 500 €
- work placements:500 € - 250 € (shorter duration)
- Summer school: 250 €
- Study trips in class: max.250 €/participant



UNIVERSITY OF ANTWERP

- Incoming students:
small grant for accommodation for students from unprivileged countries
- Academic staff:
 - Outgoing : Teaching outside Europe + Visits to partners outside Europe
 - Incoming : guest lecturing !!!!



UNIVERSITY OF ANTWERP

- Yearly budget (2006): 100.000 €
- Good news: growing demand !
 - > not sufficient
- Bad news: restrictions (most probably) need to be introduced
