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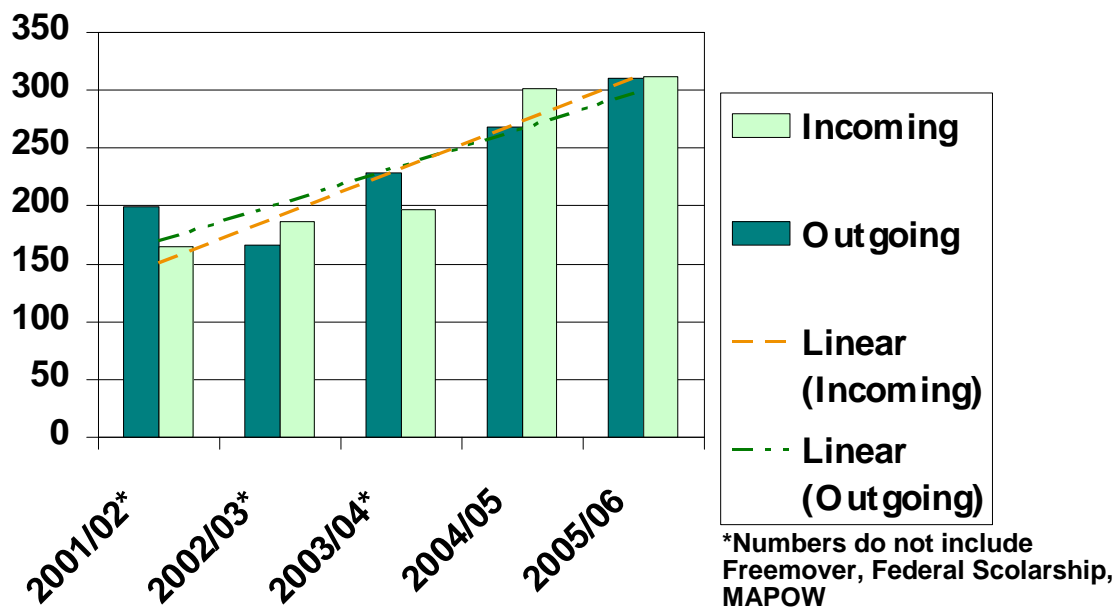

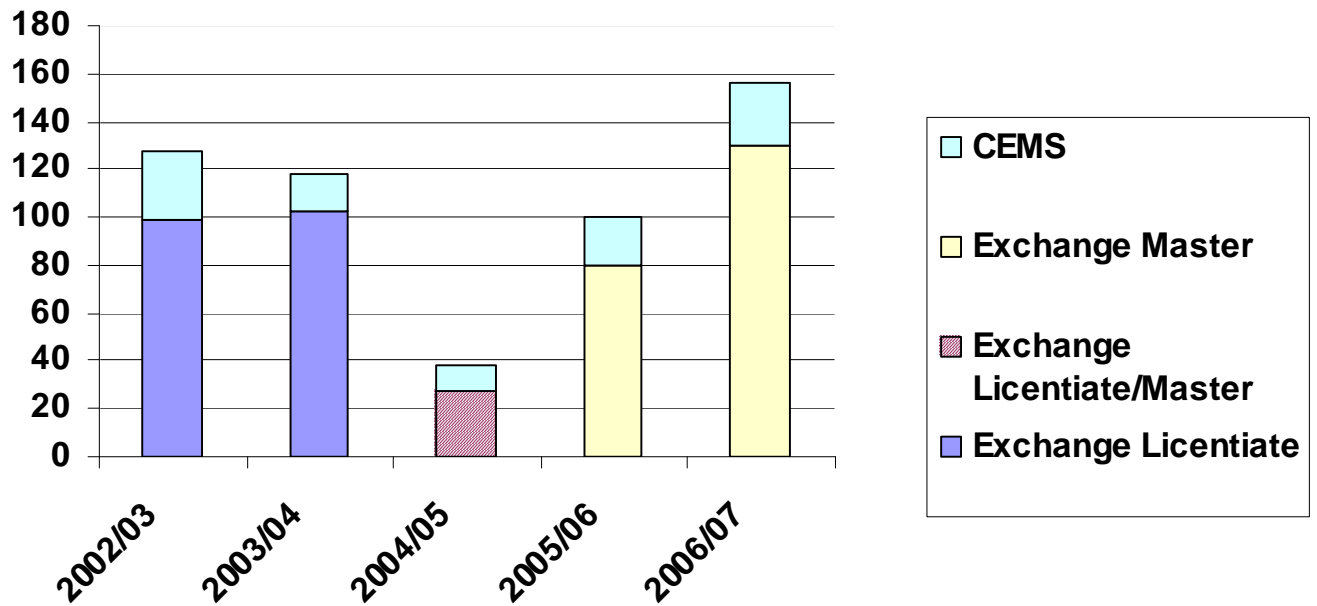

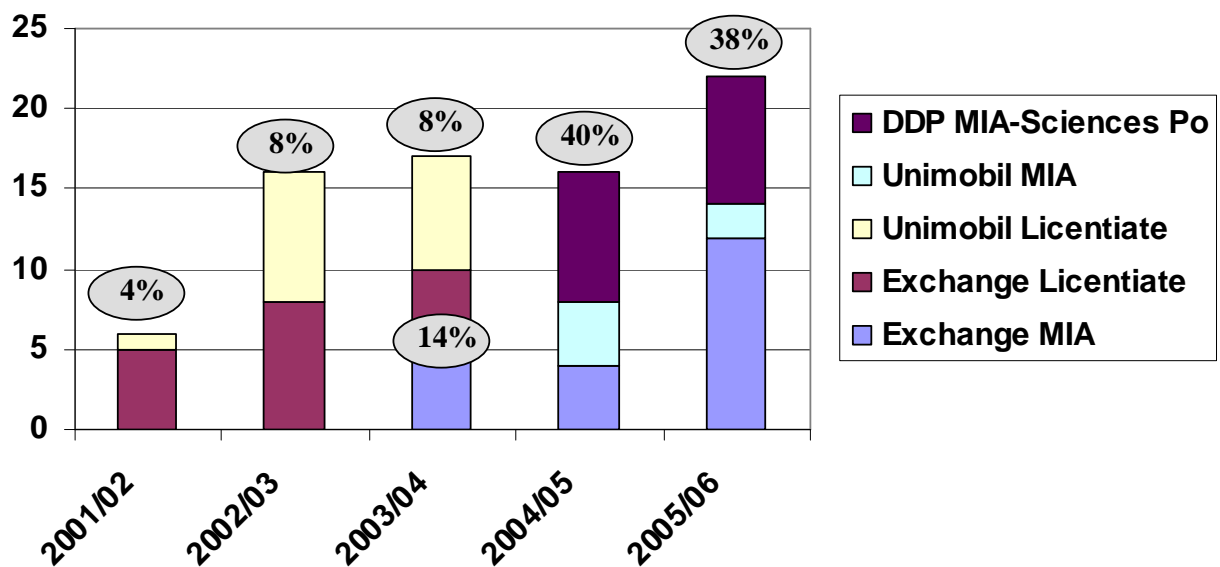
Recent Developments in Mobility I: Facts & Figures – HSG in total



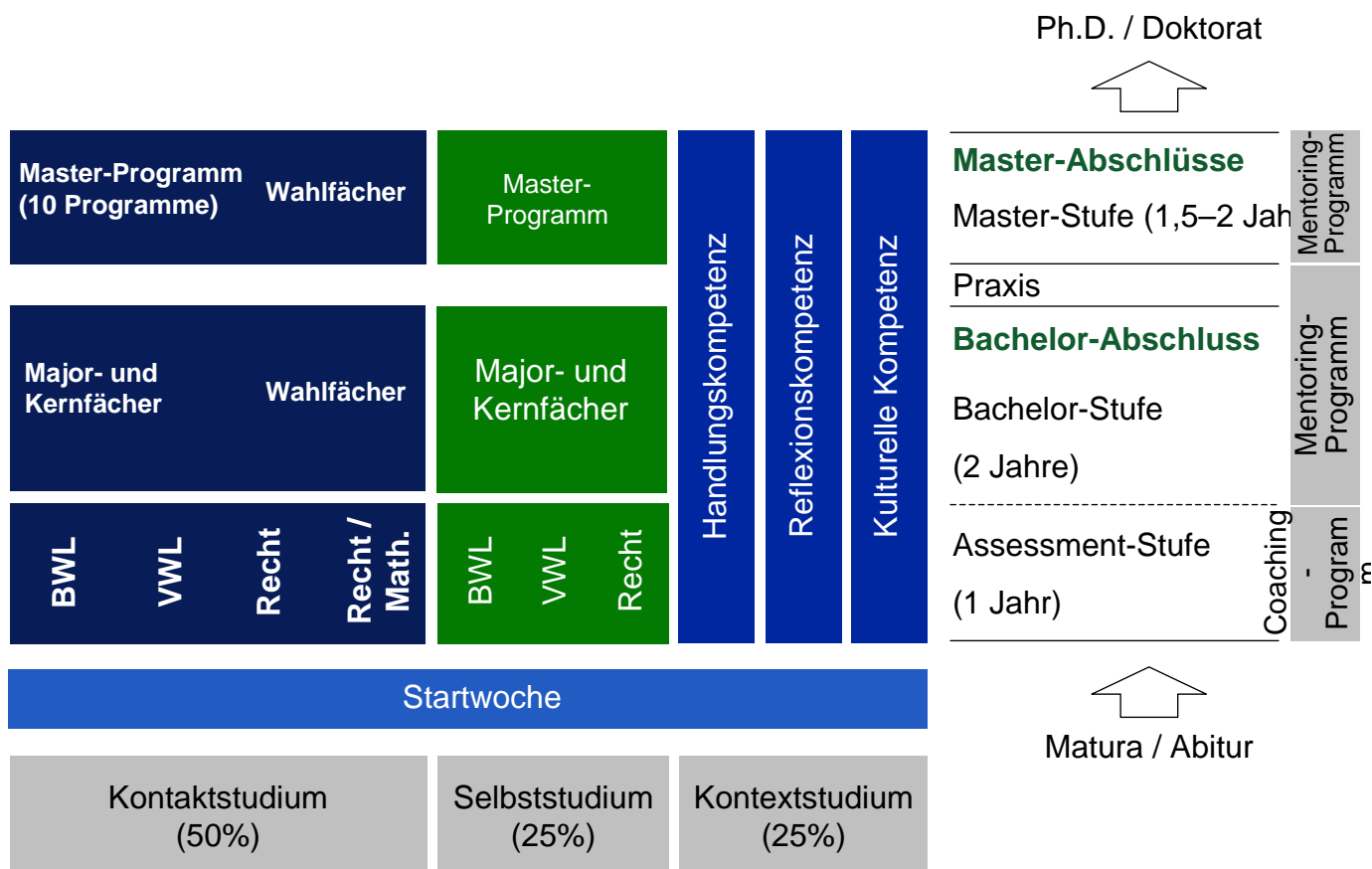
Recent Developments in Mobility II: Master's Level



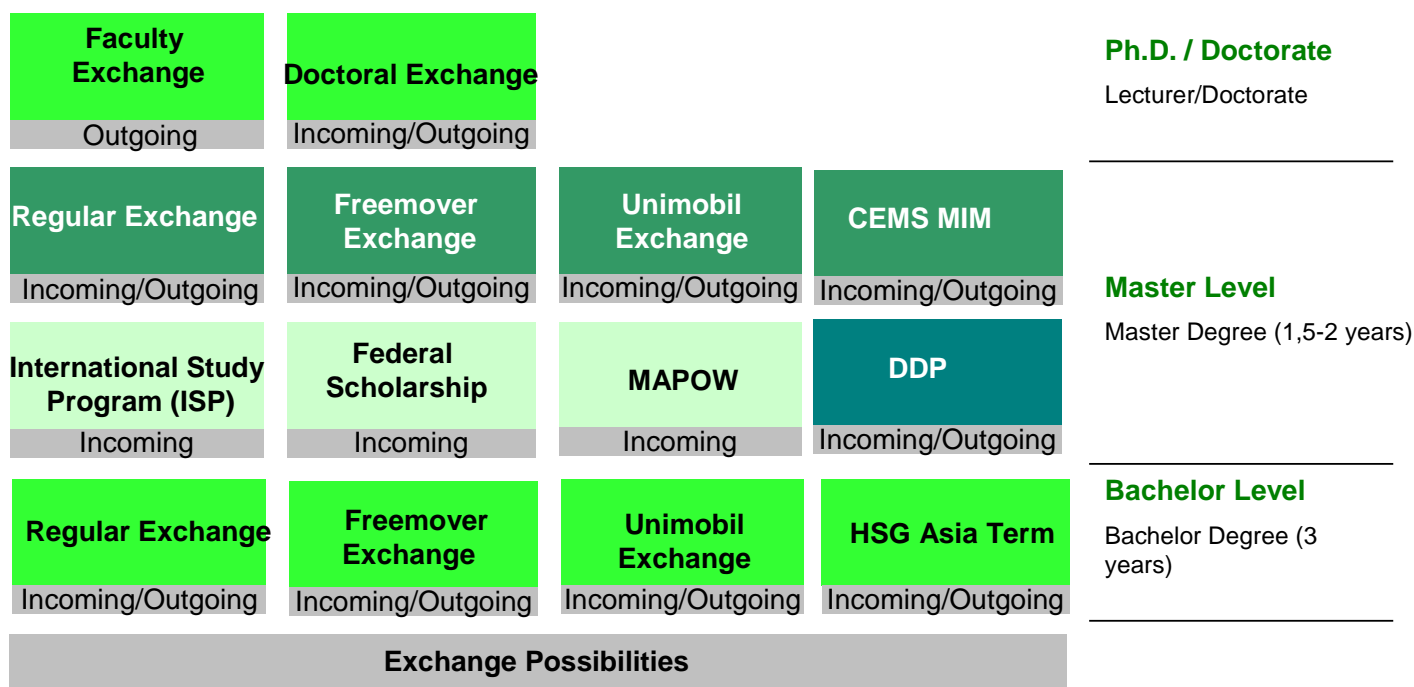
Recent Developments in Mobility III: International Affairs

- Participation of practitioners from international organisations
- Proficiency in two foreign languages

Mutual Recognition & Crediting

- Global crediting
- M.A. HSG degree: 90 ECTS
 - 60 ECTS earned at HSG + 30 ECTS credited at Sciences Po
 - choice of 30 ECTS of compulsory program and core electives
- Diplôme de Sciences Po: min. 125 ECTS
 - min. 65 ECTS obtained at Sciences Po + all 60 ECTS credited at HSG

Selection Process I: Criteria

- Academic performance
- Personality and extracurricular activities
- Motivation/credibility
- Proficiency in French/German

Selection Process II: Joint committee

- Pre-selection by MIA program by end of December
- Interview with joint selection committee (2 rep. HSG, 1 rep. Sciences Po) in January
- Selection by end of January 2005

- 2 references (German, French or English)
