



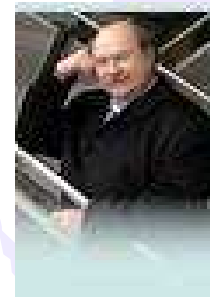

des Atlantiks hat.**



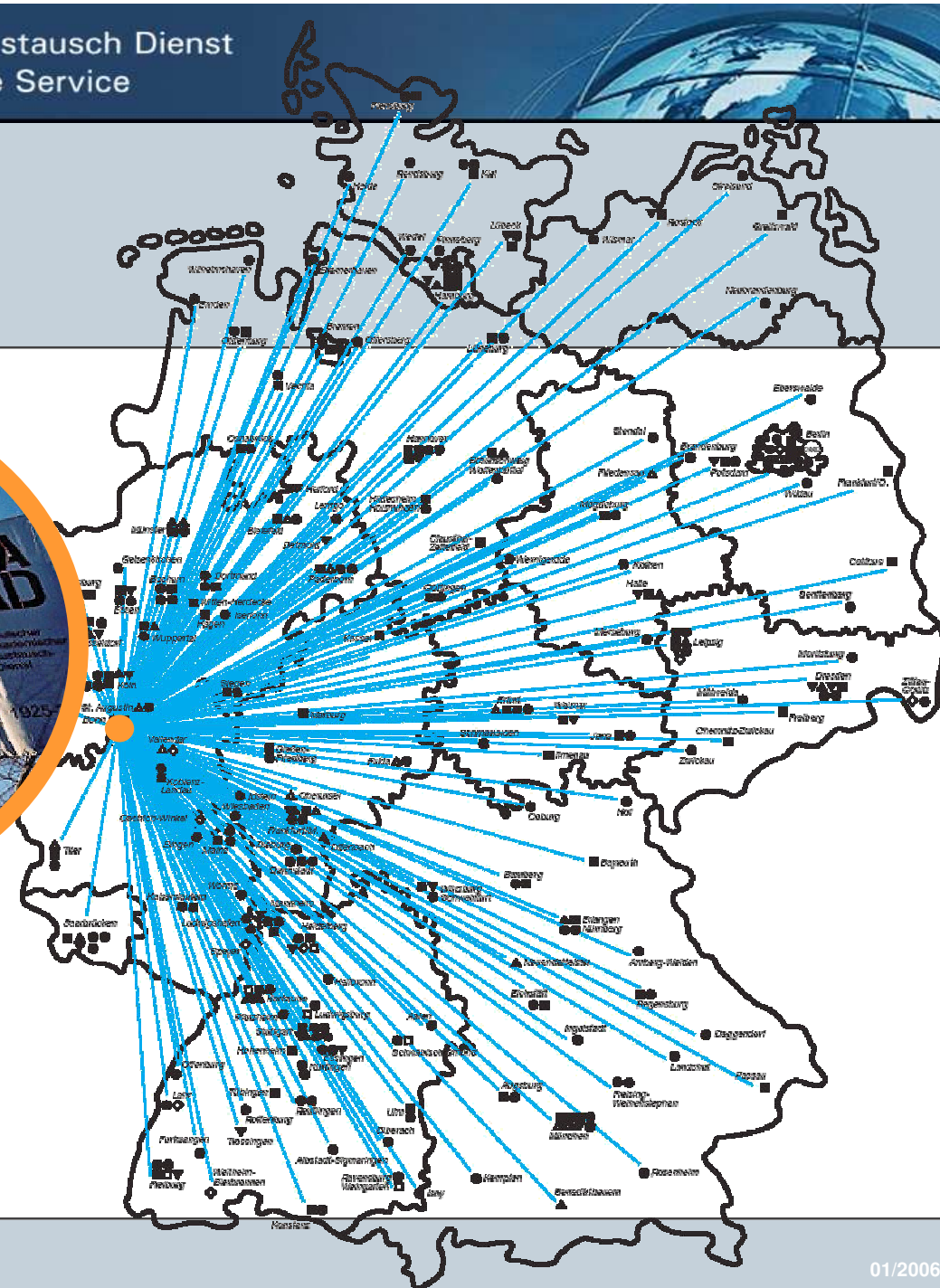

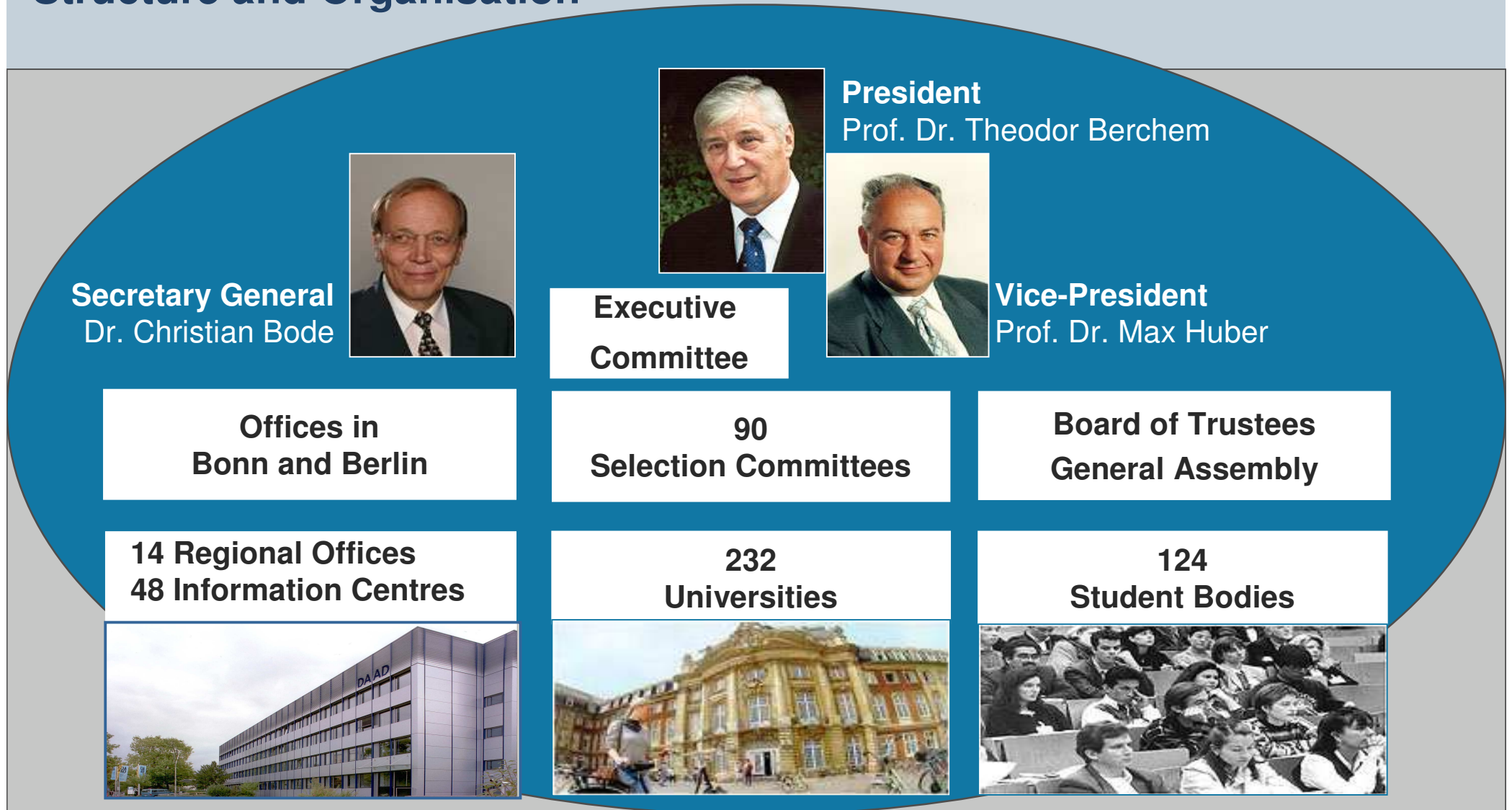

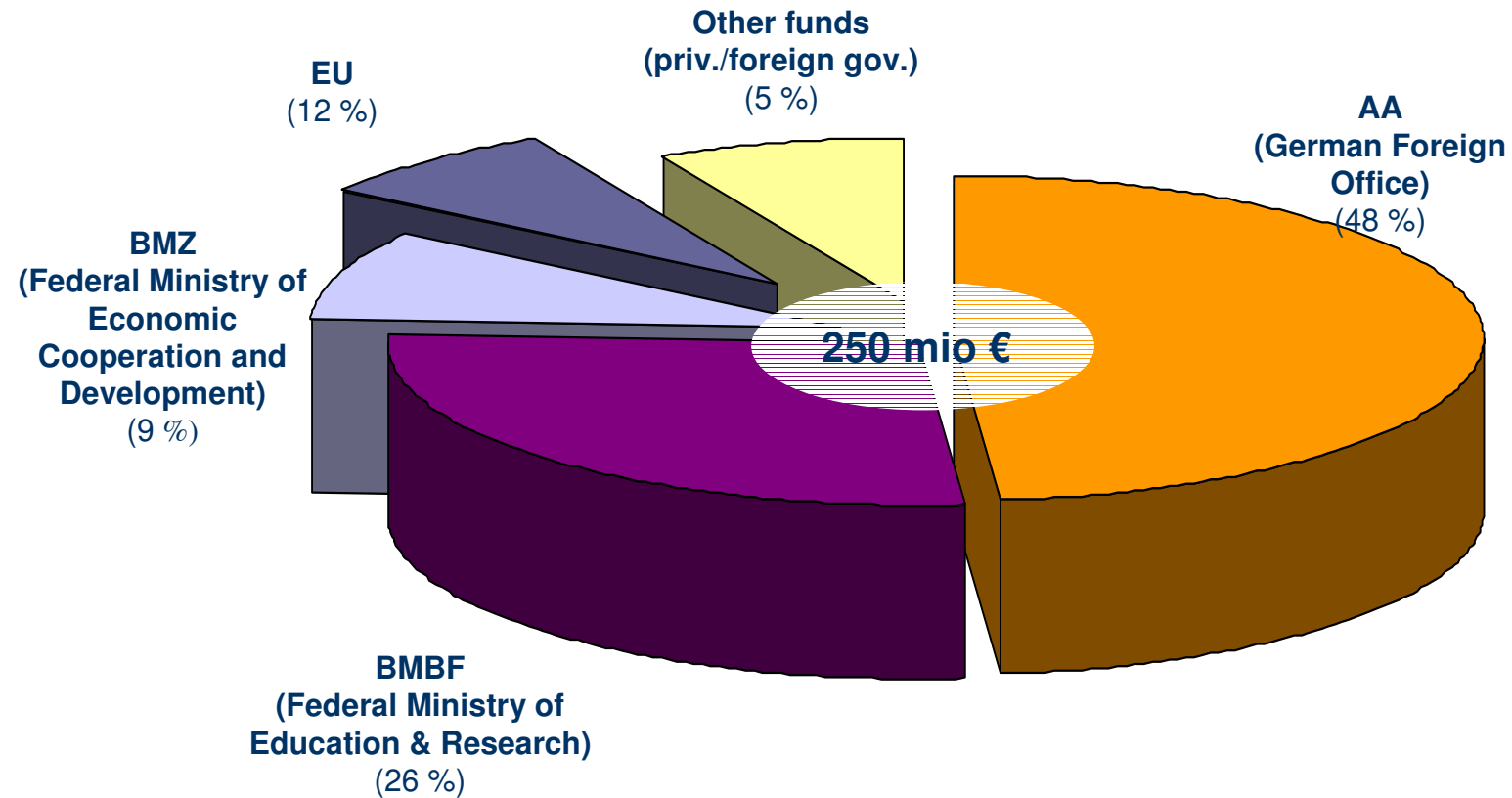

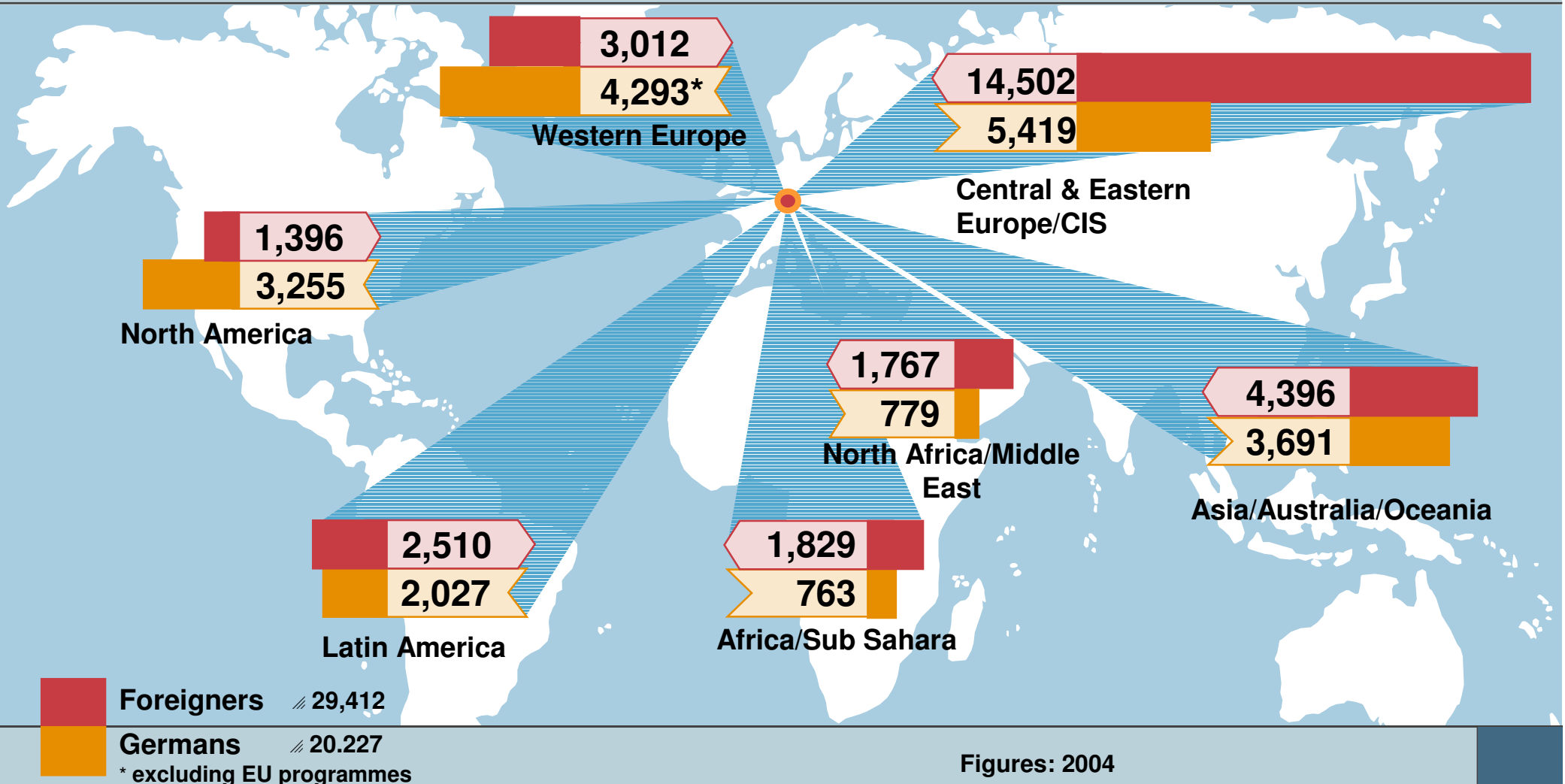


DAAD Budget 2005



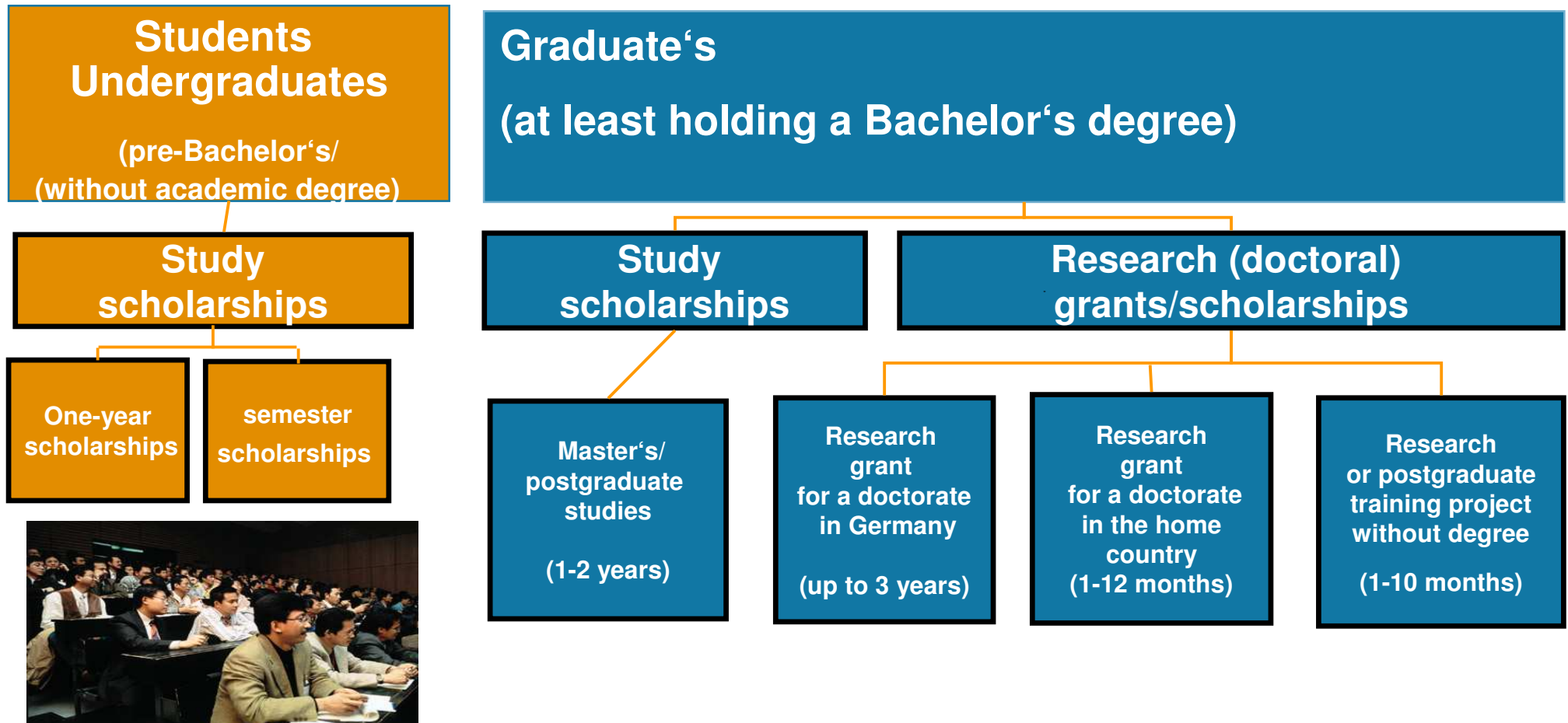


DAAD scholarship holders: regions of origin and target regions





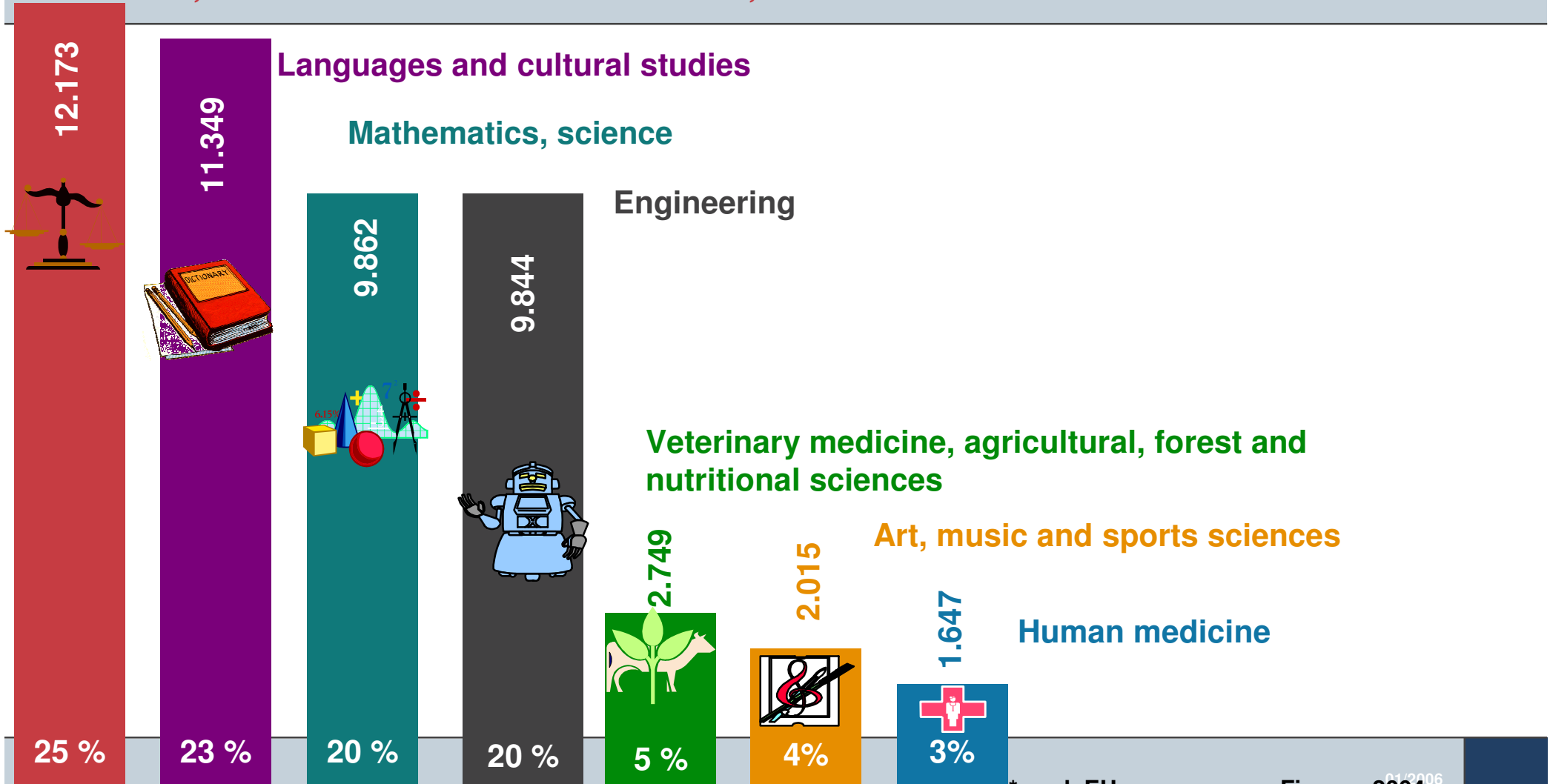
