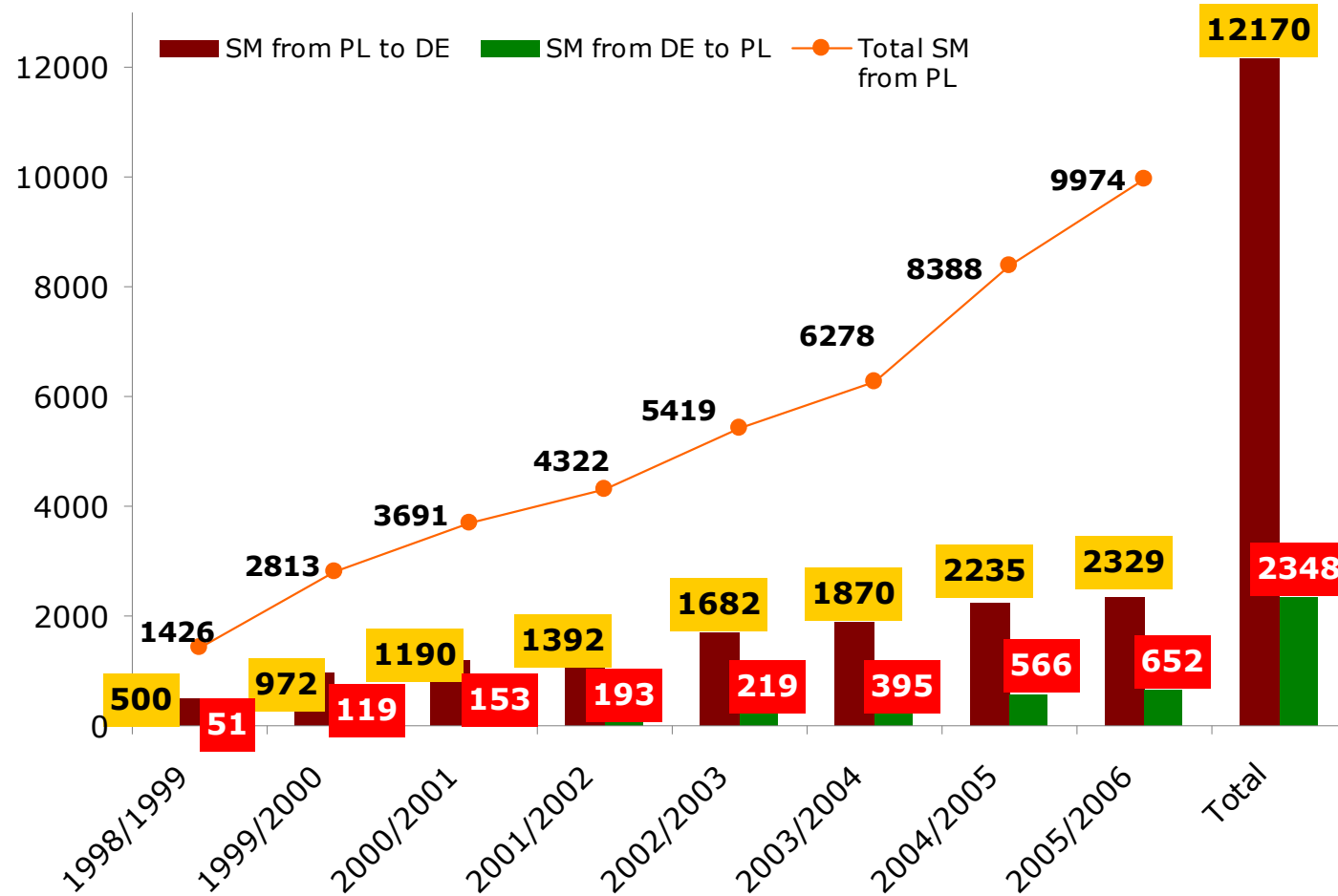

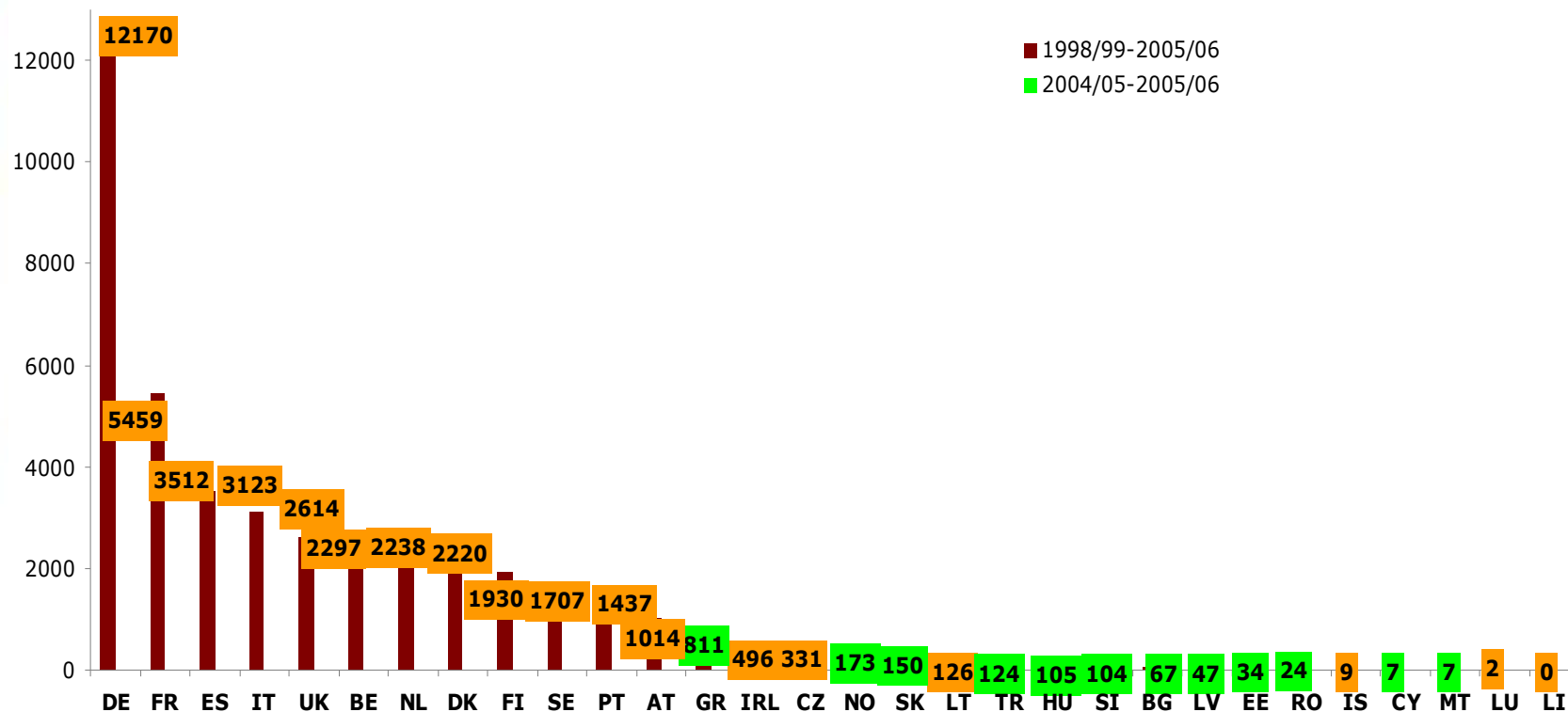

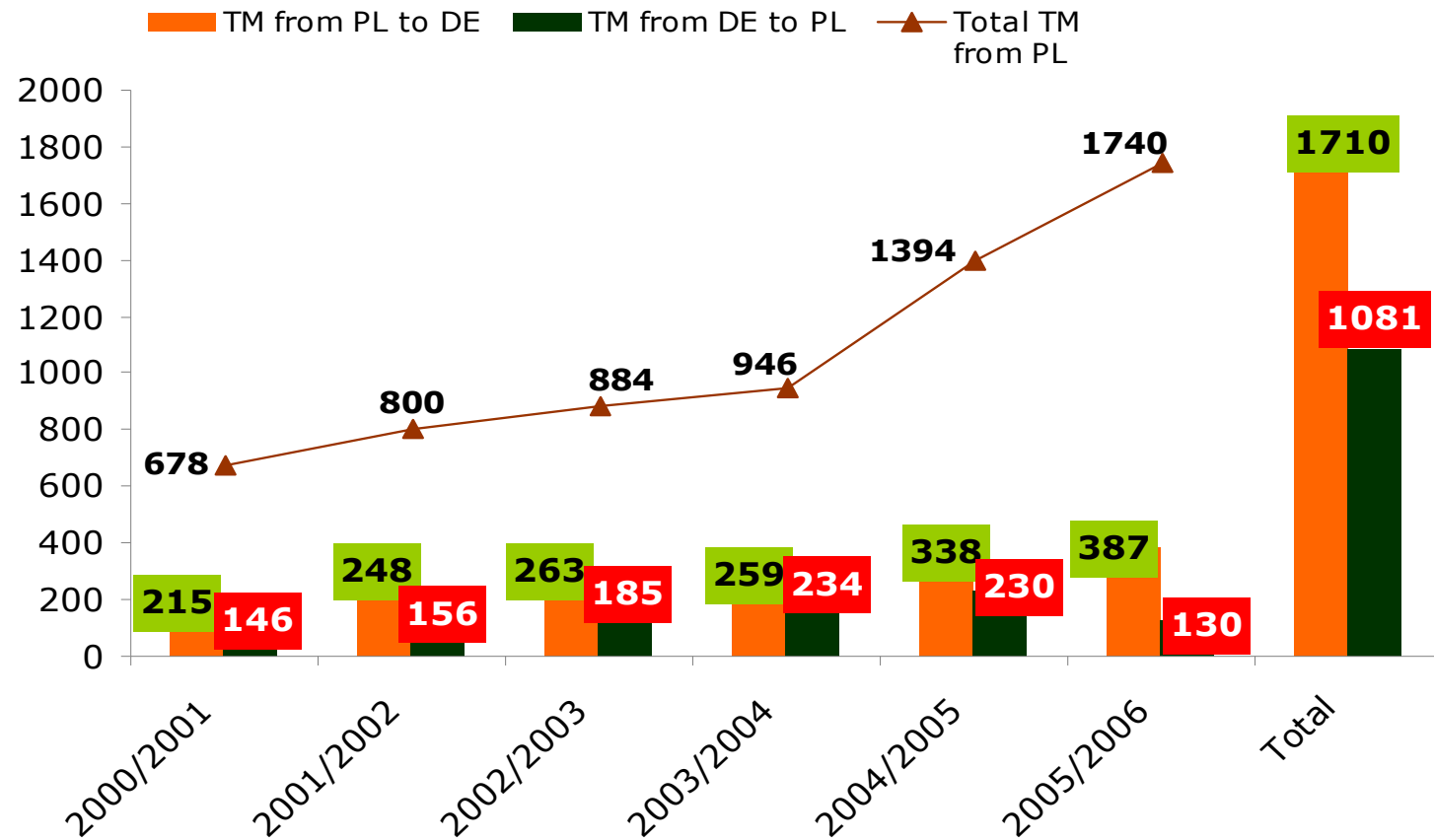
# Student Mobility: Poland - Europe 30

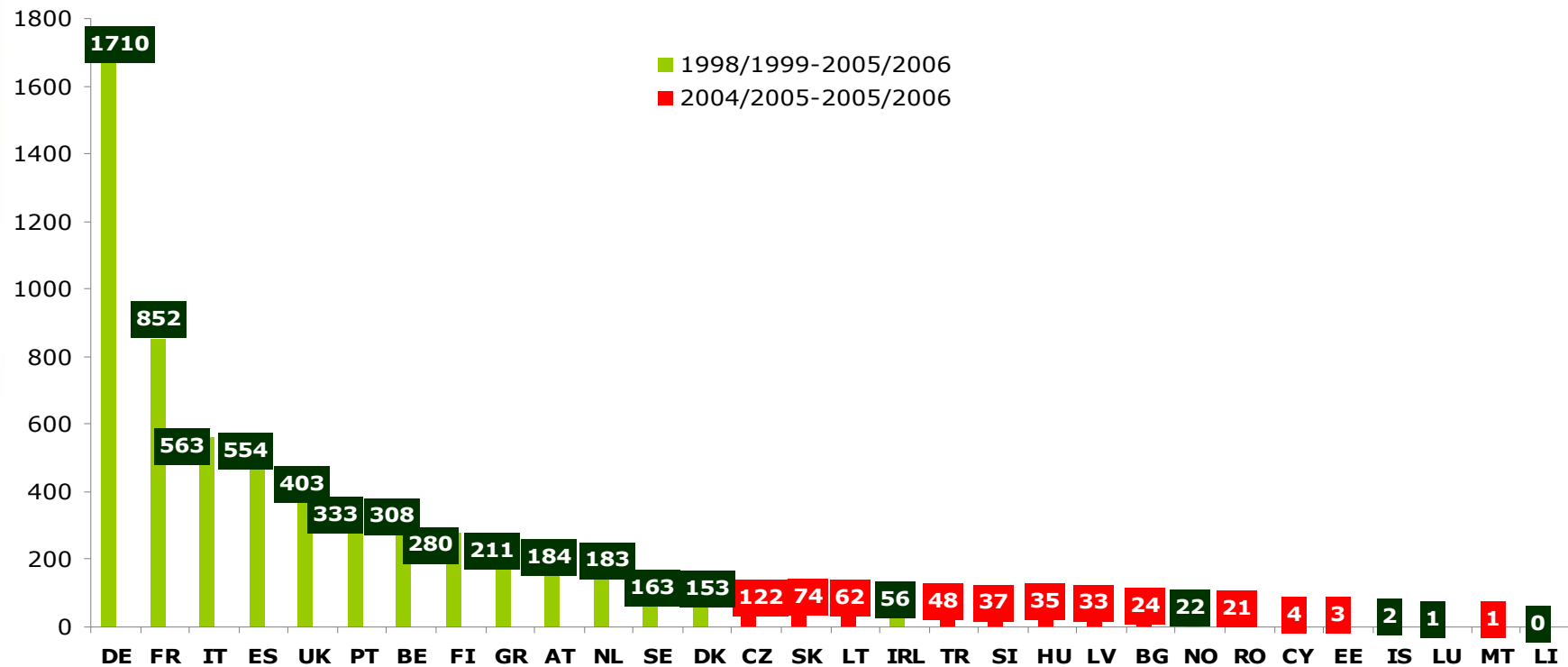
