# Tempus IV in Russia

- ▶ Priorities identified through consultations with the EU Delegation and Ministry of Education and Science
- ▶ Special attention given to:
  - modernization of curricula,
  - joint programmes leading to double/multiple diplomas
  - structural measures projects



# Joint projects

- ▶ Modernisation of curricula
- ▶ ECTS, recognition of diplomas and degrees
  - Disciplines:
    - ▶ Social work, tourism and service sector, pedagogy, engineering, ICT, philosophy, ecology, biotechnologies
- ▶ Higher education and society:
  - Lifelong learning
  - Qualification frameworks



# Structural measures

- ▶ Higher education and society:
  - Lifelong learning
  - Qualification frameworks



## JP vs SM

- ▶ Seeming overlapping in Higher education and society (lifelong learning and qualification frameworks)
- ▶ Difference:
  - JP more bottom-up oriented, creating the critical mass at universities
  - SM more oriented at systemic input and offering insights into legislative and institutional framework to ensure sustainability of outputs/models produced at the university level, national policy level oriented



# Regional/multi-country projects

- ▶ Hugely important to ensure:
  - addressing issues of common interest aiming at networking on the policy and university levels
  - addressing issues not in the National Priorities, but nevertheless relevant for HE modernization in Russia (one of such issues – improvement of university management by introducing process management)



# Special issues requiring mention

- ▶ Preparation of applications:
  - To be done jointly by partner country and EU universities
    - ▶ (cases when it is done largely by EU universities, with RF partners to find out later that some of their needs have not been addressed, or that not all RF partners enjoy equal benefits from the project)



# Special issues requiring mention

- ▶ Preparation of applications:
  - Please ask RF universities to clearly state how:
    - ▶ the project fits into their Development Strategy,
    - ▶ in real terms the university administration will use its outputs to the benefit of the university on the whole



# Special issues requiring mention. Preparation of applications

Please give special attention to:

- ▶ mechanisms of project management and communication between all partners
- ▶ dissemination strategy (make RF partners think seriously about it, not just a final conference, or publication of project materials)
- ▶ sustainability ( let RF partners provide evidence in the long-standing demand for the project outputs)
- ▶ log-frame (as it will be used for project monitoring purposes), and especially to indicators that should be concrete and measurable
- ▶ ensuring that all partners have a role (sometimes employers are included just because it's good to have them to give weight to the consortium)



# Overview of the Second Call Outcomes

## Projects involving Russia

- ▶ Applications submitted – 62
- ▶ Supported:
  - 9 national,
  - 5 regional (multi-country)
  - Of them: 12 JPs, 2 SMs

- ▶ Total: 8
- ▶ German university as grant-holder - 4
- ▶ German universities as partners - 4
