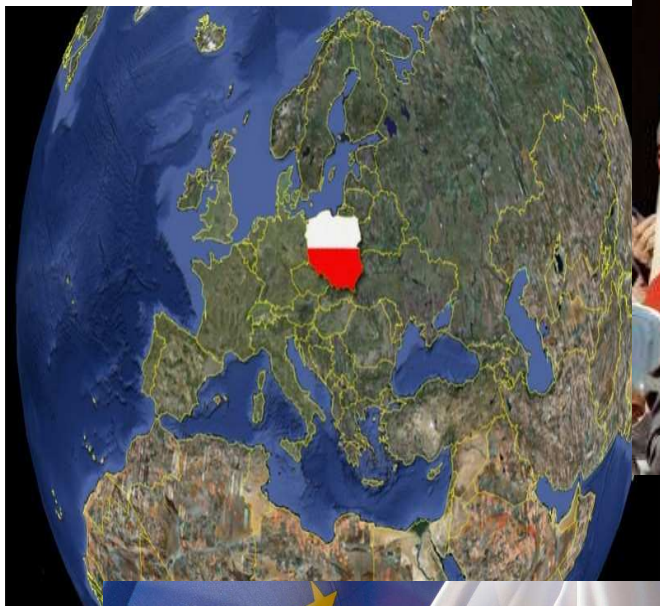

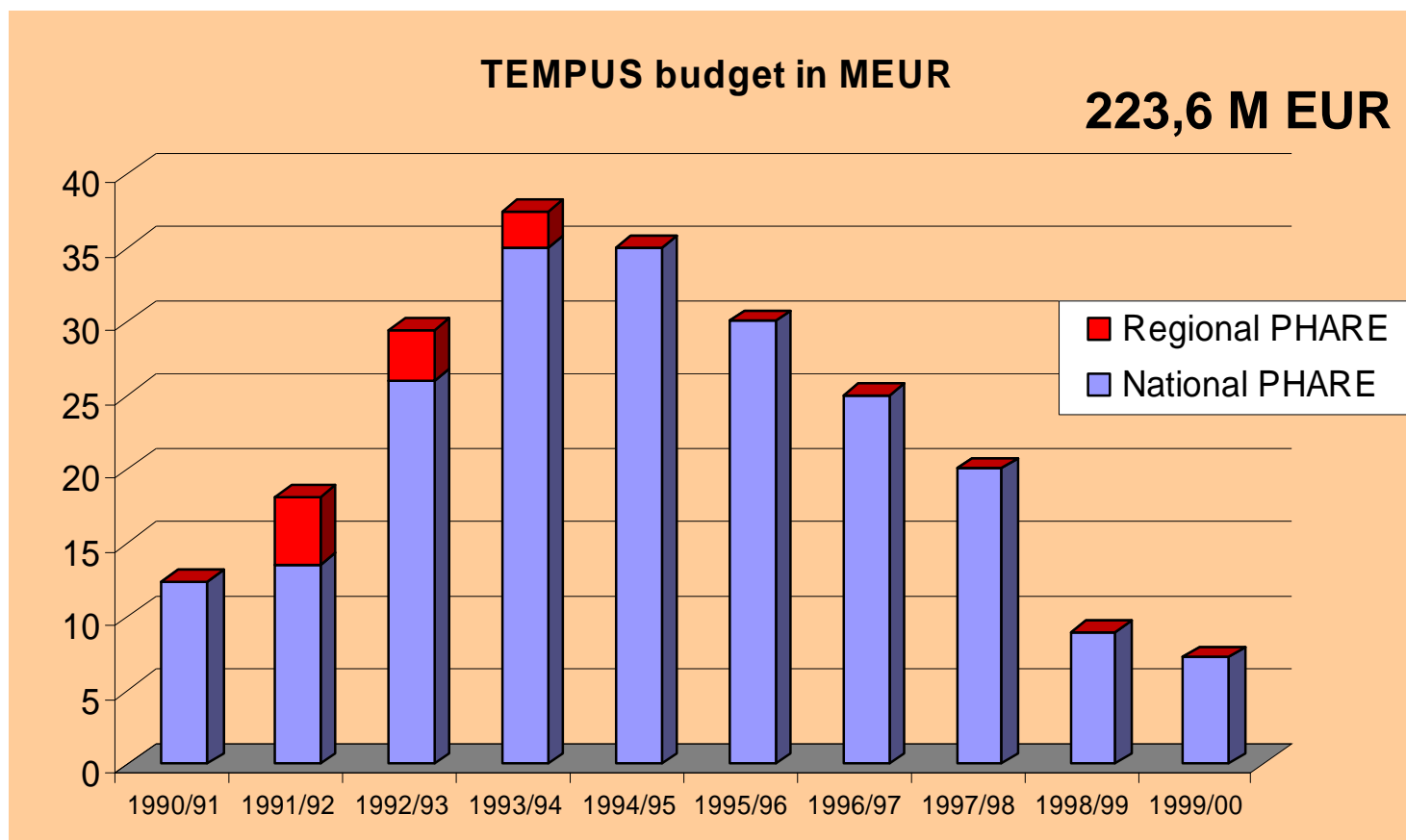

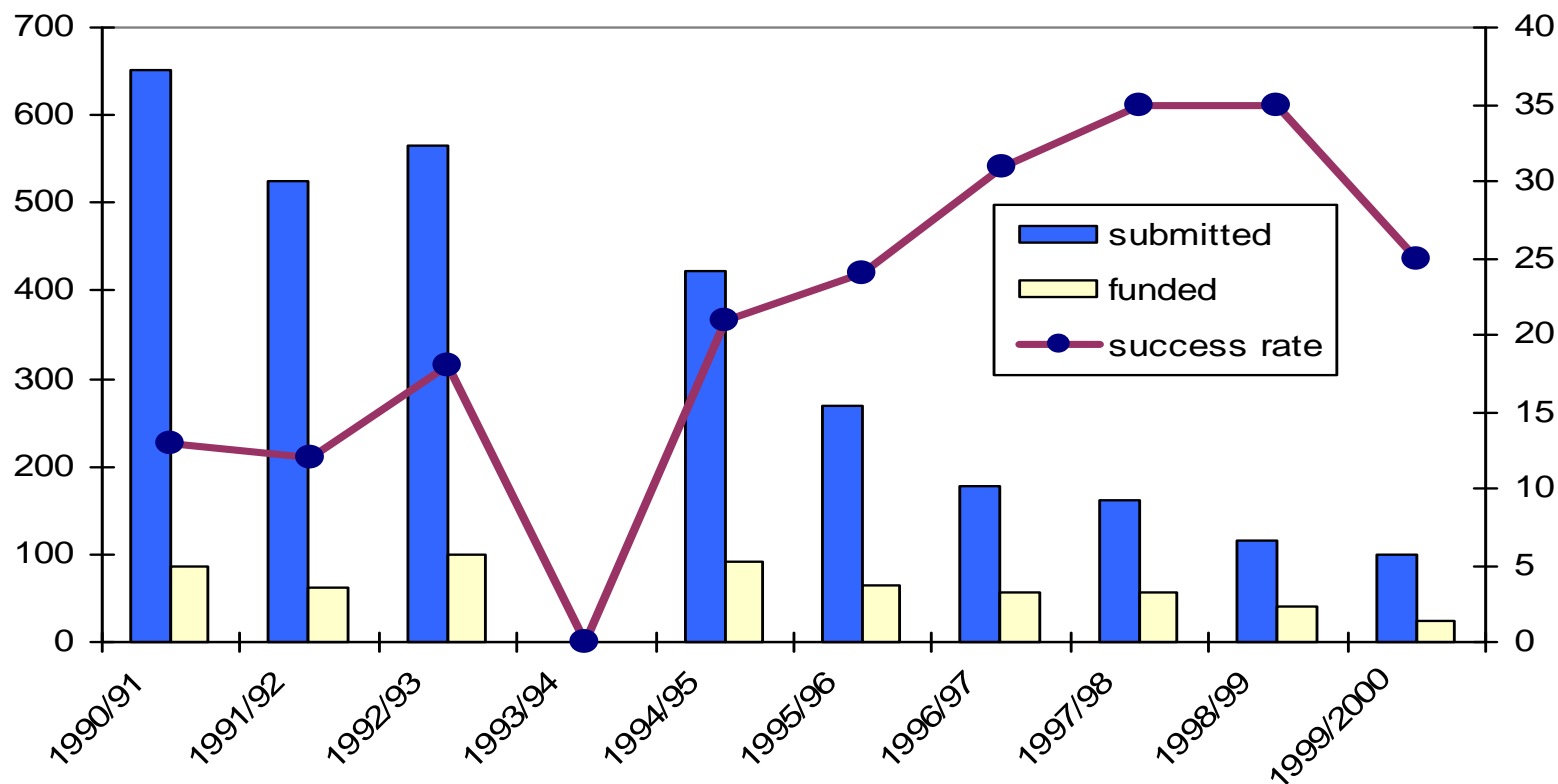

From the very first JEPs applications...

- ✓ Name of the legal representative: „Z wyrazami szacunku” (i.e. „Yours sincerely”)

- ✓ ... text here to be filled in by Polish university...

„Polish JEPs” – precursor of the Bologna Process? Some of Polish priorities in TEMPUS I and II

- ✓ transformation of uniform 5-year study programme into two-stage (BSc-MSc) system,
- ✓ introduction of credit (and credit transfer) system and flexible study system,
- ✓ introduction of new specialisations and professional profiles in response to the job market needs,
- ✓ introduction of European dimension into the curricula (development of European studies),
- ✓ introduction of quality assurance system

TEMPUS I and II - tangible results

- ✓ Creation of new university units
- ✓ Development of new study programmes and modernisation of existing curricula
- ✓ Introduction of European studies
- ✓ Introduction of English language courses
- ✓ Development of new teaching materials
- ✓ Upgrading of teaching equipment

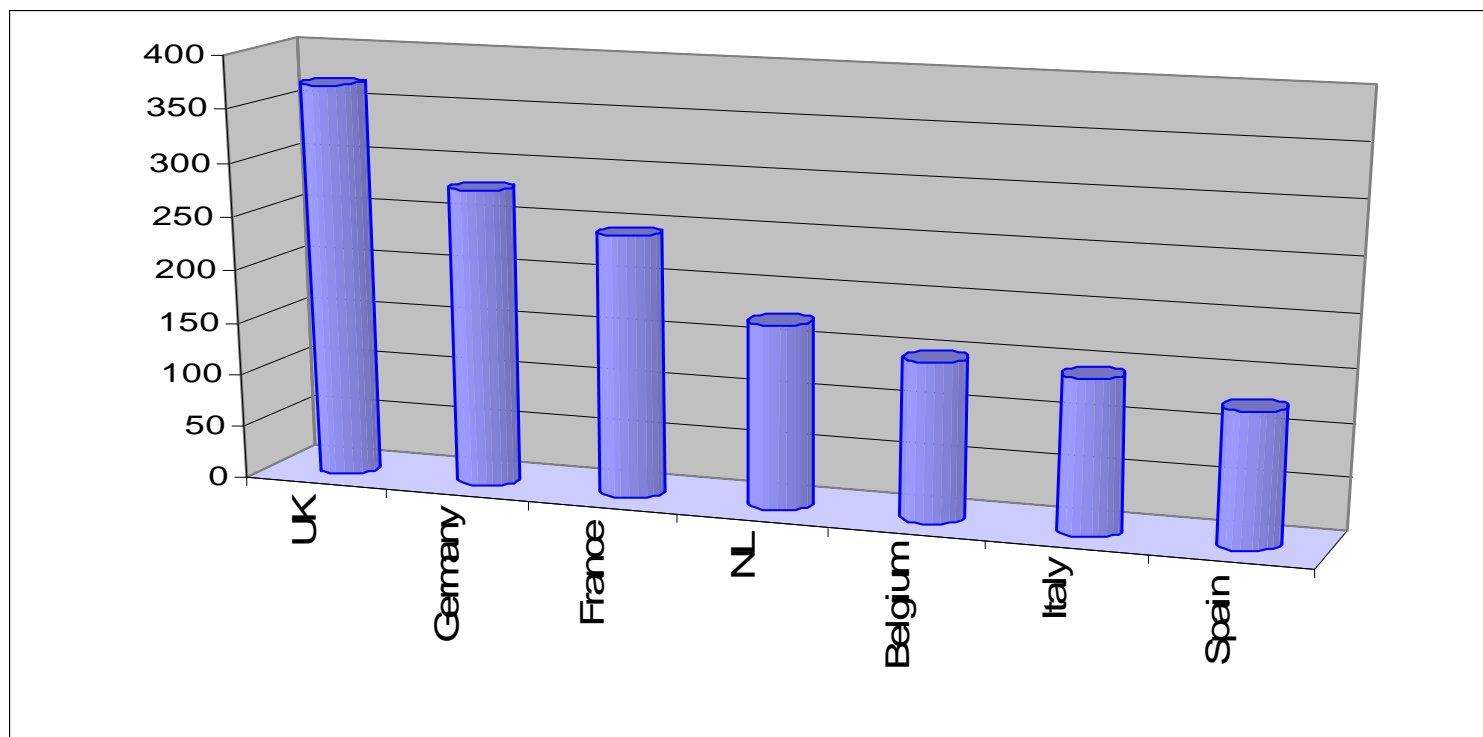

- ✓ Coordinating/ contracting skills
- ✓ Project culture
- ✓ Preparation for EU programmes (Socrates, 5th Framework Programme)
- ✓ Teacher–student relations
- ✓ Language skills
- ✓ Knowledge about Poland
- ✓ Cooperation and joint activities of Polish HEIs

TEMPUS in Poland after 2000

✓ TEMPUS III:

- ✓ 2000 - 2004 „blank page” for Poland
- ✓ „comeback” with 63 projects in 2004-2006

✓ TEMPUS IV - unsatisfactory level of participation:

- only 30 projects with Polish participation
- only 1 with a Polish HEI as an applicant

- 2) Warsaw University
- 3) Jagiellonian University in Kraków

TEMPUS III:

- 1) University of Life Sciences in Warsaw

TEMPUS I

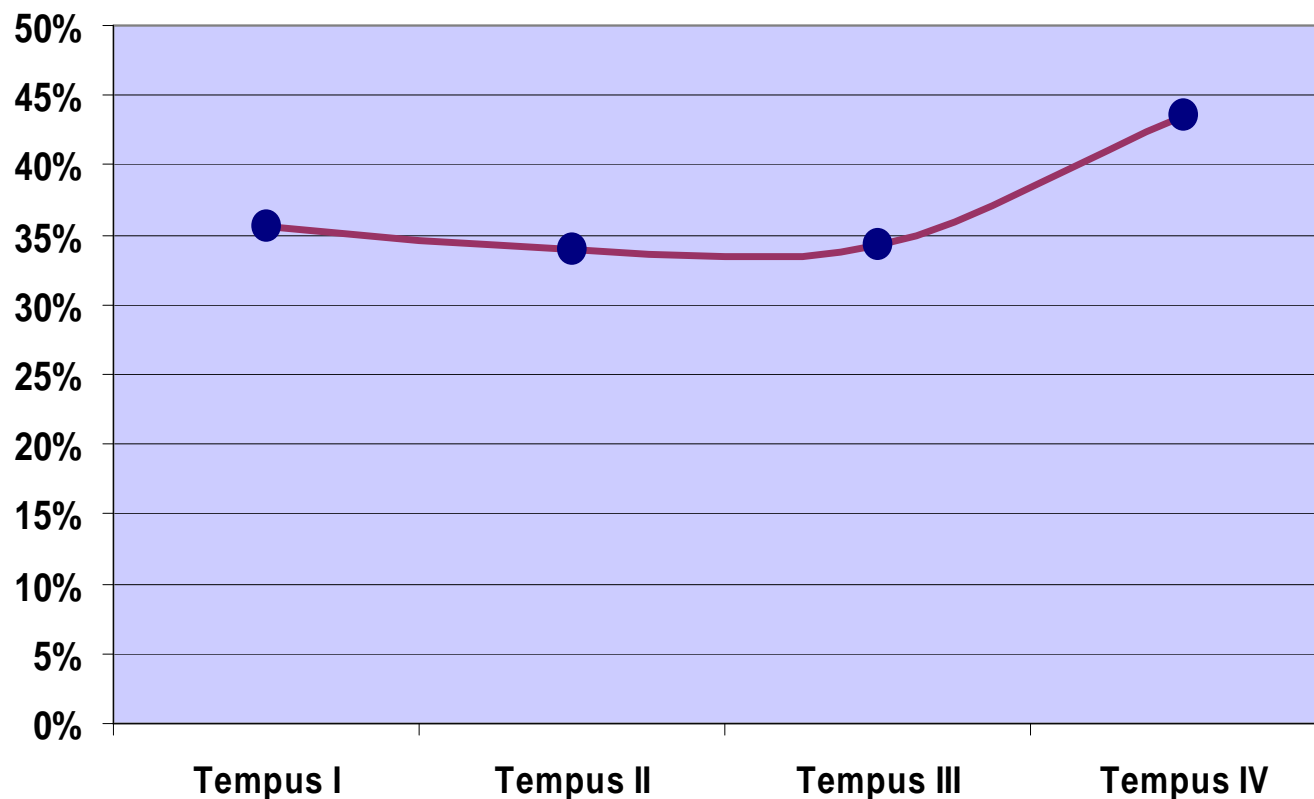
Participation of eastern German universities as Tempus beneficiary institutions (until reunification in 1991)

- ✓ *12 projects*
- ✓ *2 Million DM (1 Million EUR)*

Possibility for all German universities to intensify cooperation with eastern neighbours

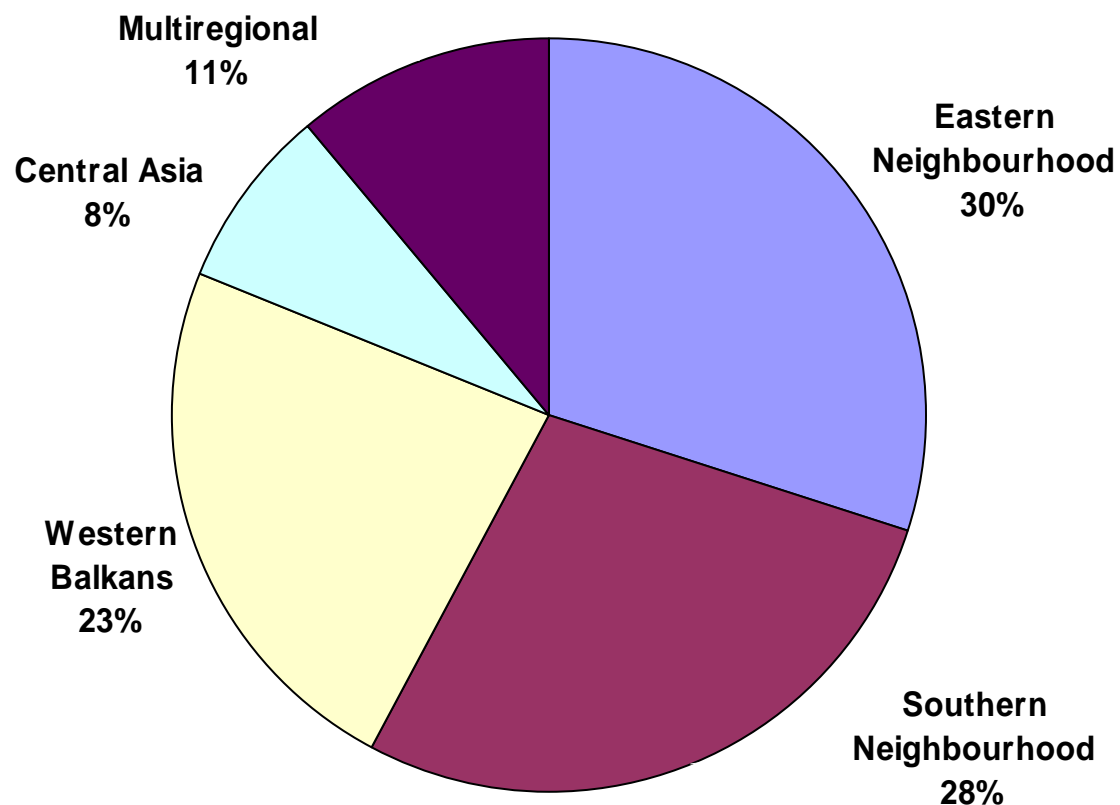

German participation from Tempus I to Tempus IV



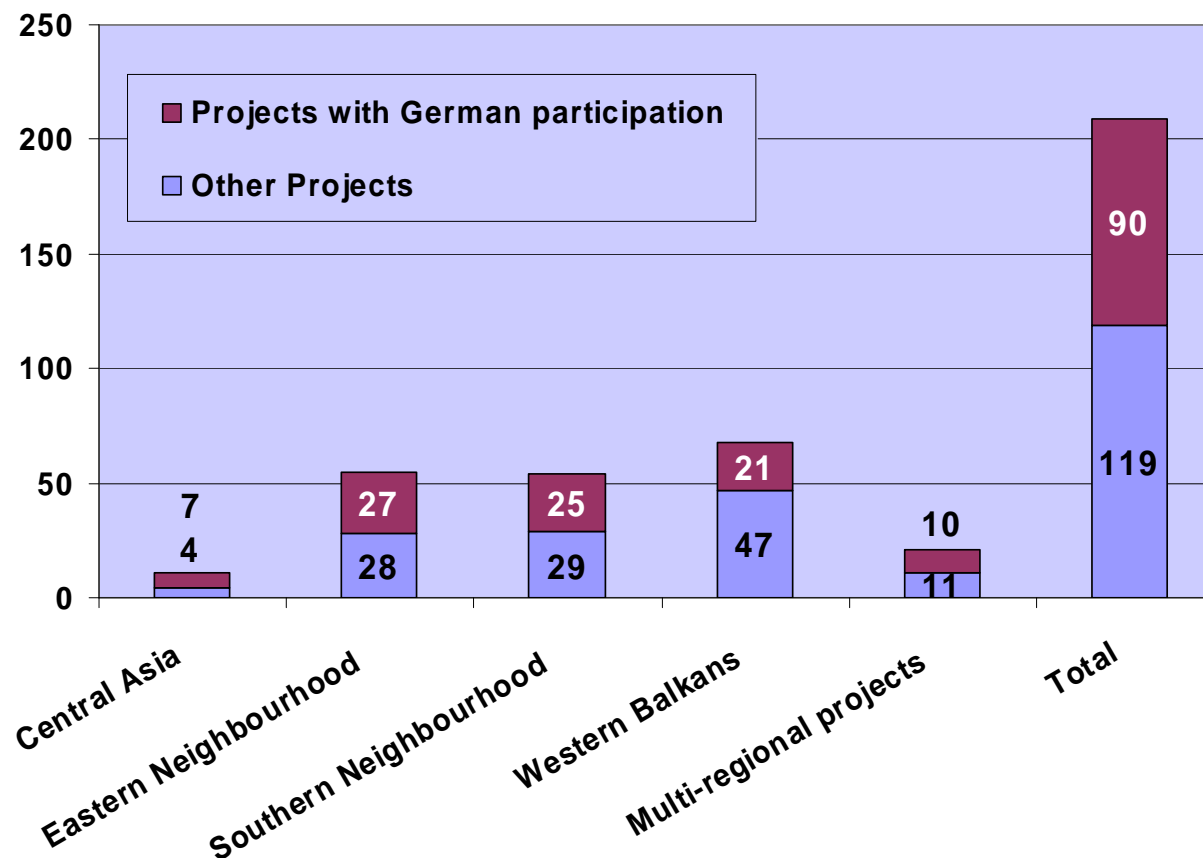

German partner regions in Tempus IV



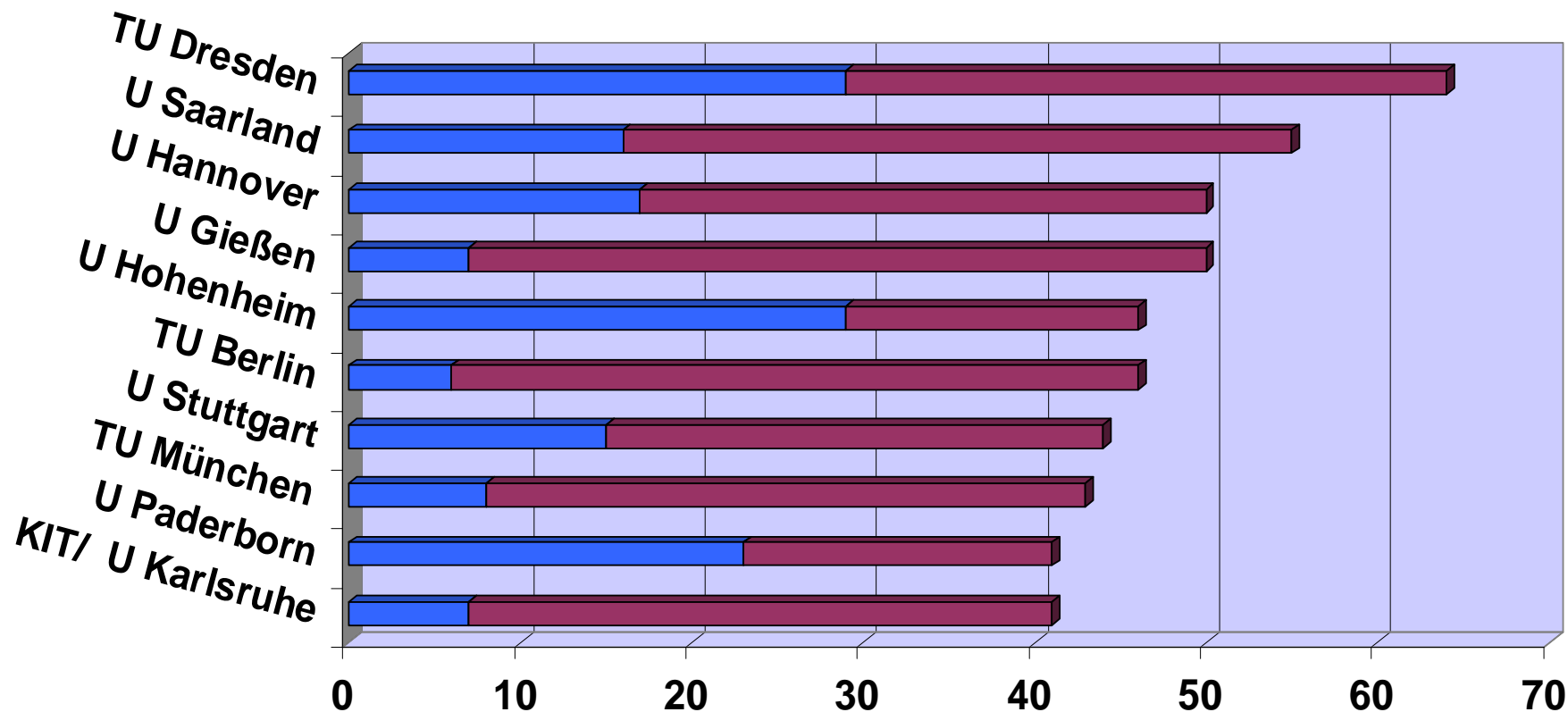

German participation in Tempus - conclusions

- Active participation in Tempus:

Tempus I-IV: Third after Great Britain and France - Tempus IV: First

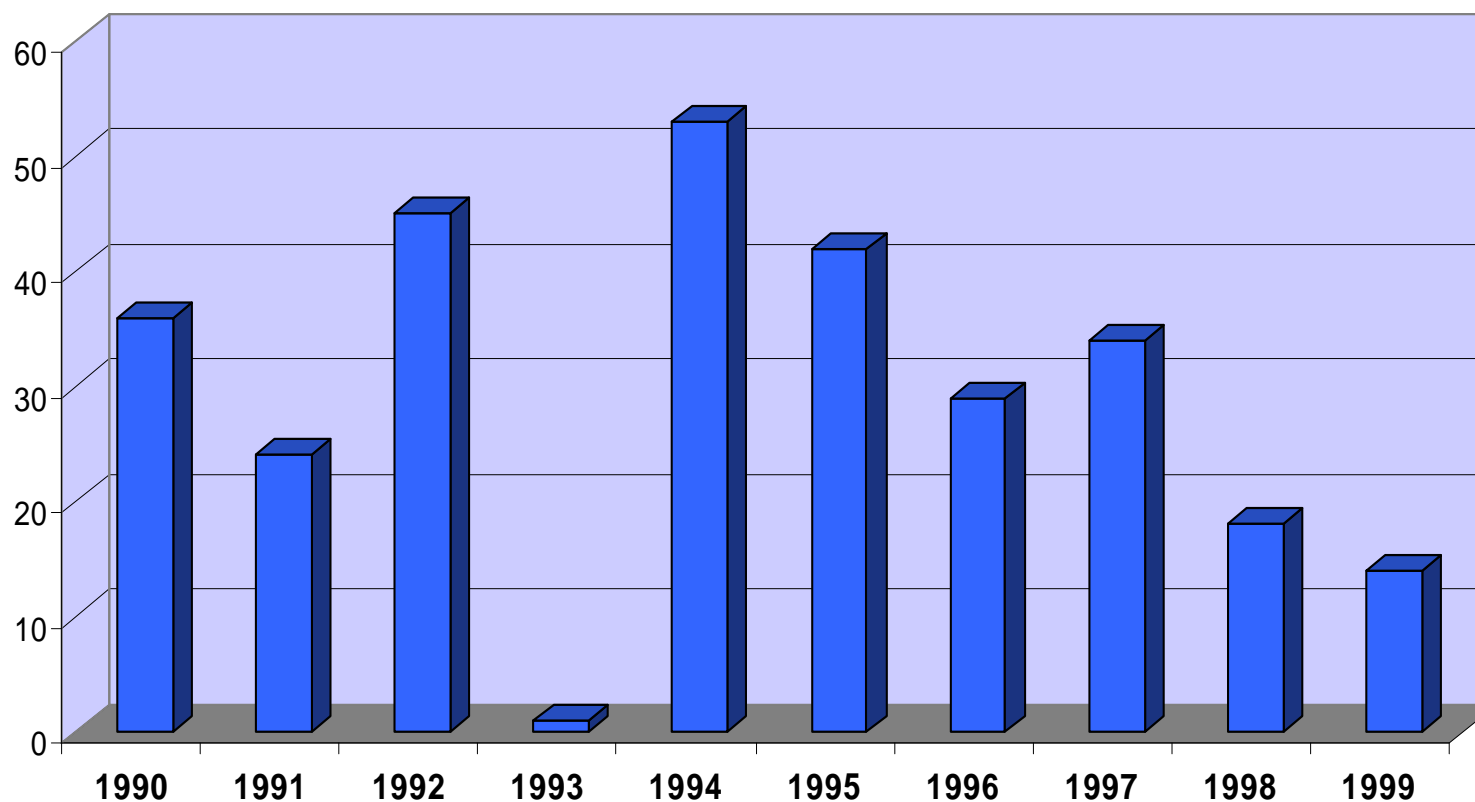
- Useful instrument to intensify cooperation with Tempus partner regions
- Tempus as a first step towards intensified cooperation (e.g. common research, FP7, Phd exchange)
- Tempus subjects are also relevant for German universities (e.g. Bologna)
- Benefits not only for partner countries: strengthening of internationalisation of EU universities and creation of new partnerships

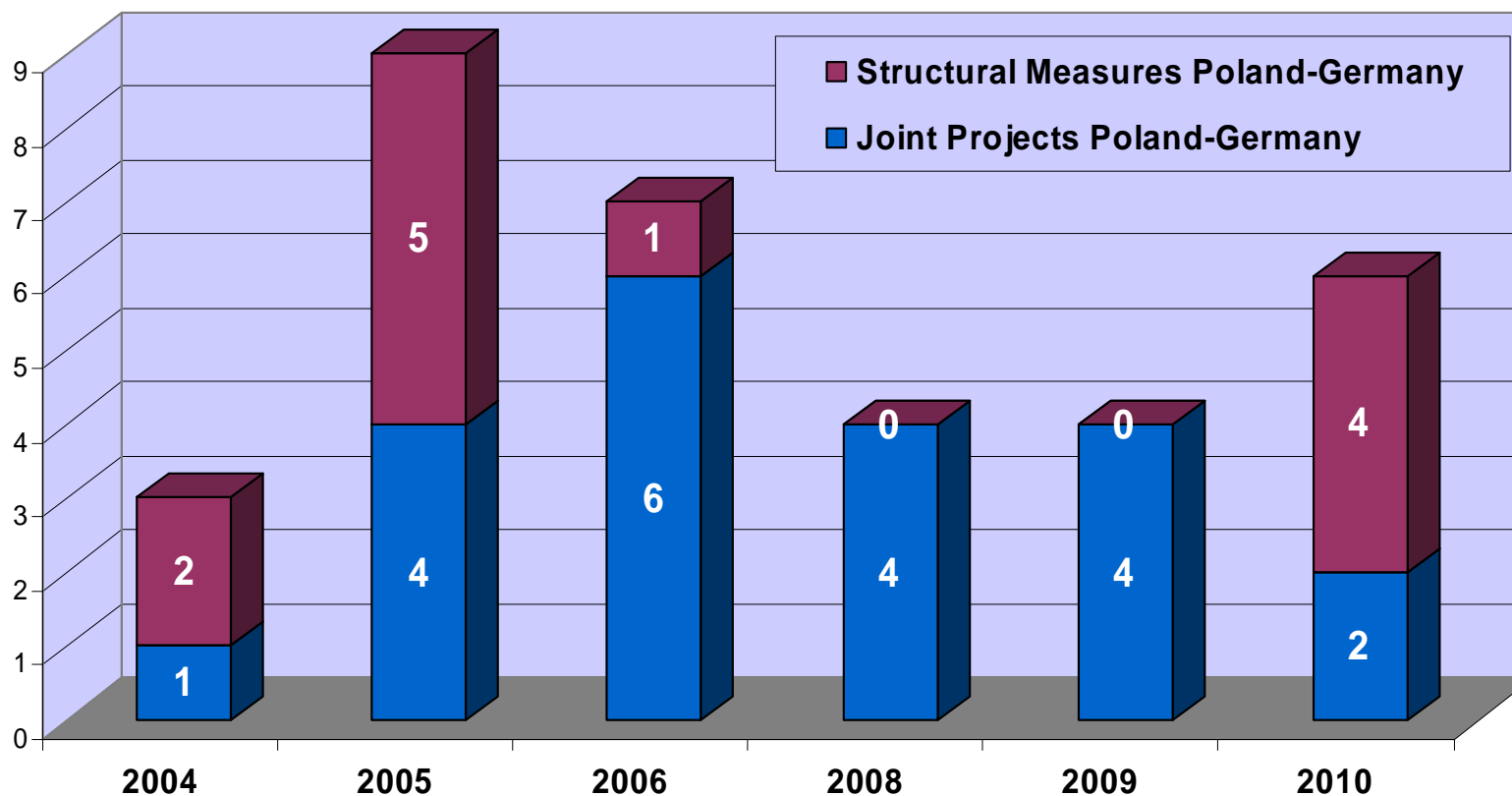

German-Polish TEMPUS projects 1990-1999



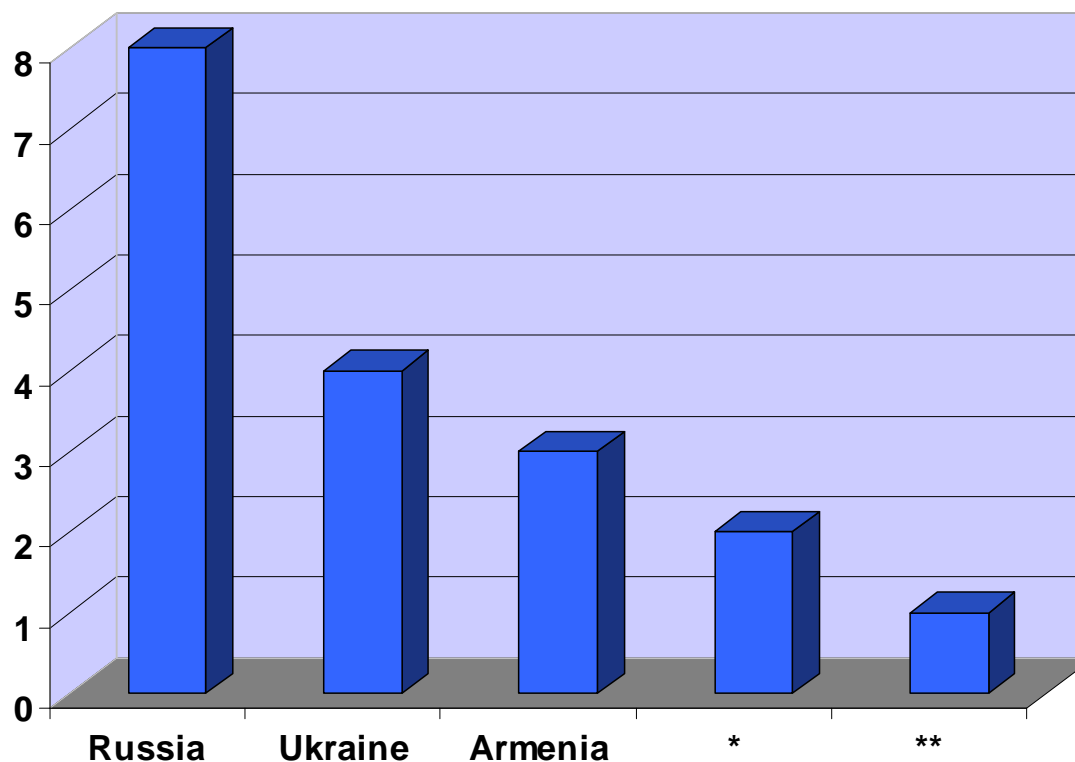
