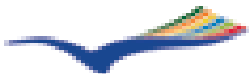

# WHAT ARE THE GOALS OF EEE4ALL?

## ◉ EMPLOYABILITY:

To increase (re)employability for the disadvantaged groups due to age, ethnicity-migration, disability and/or gender from various perspectives

## ◉ EDUCATION:

To design an educational model(s) that will enable students to design strategies to promote employment for those furthest removed from the labour through TUNING methodology, innovative teaching and best practice

## ◉ MULTILATERALITY:

To stress social dimension of Bologna declaration by **bridging the gap** through developing multilateral modules (international, interdisciplinary, across sectors)

## ◉ OVERALL:

To link resources and beneficiaries and seek donors in order to ensure long-term **independent funding** of the proposed project beyond 24 months.

## TO SUMMARIZE→

- Need for projects to bridge the gap between policy and practice and focus on the most vulnerable groups of employable persons whilst adhering to the TUNING and Bologna principles

# PREPARATION PHASE

- ◉ Is there a NEED for “new” education?
- ◉ Who is the right Partner for your consortium?
- ◉ Collaboration - what that means?
- ◉ Finding the right funding body - who can help you?
- ◉ “Know how”

# MAKING AN APPLICATION

- ◉ Mutual understanding between partners
- ◉ Are you familiar with European Policy?
- ◉ Why you need European Education - what is the added value?
- ◉ Will this increase and sustain the mobility?
- ◉ Is it innovative or ...?
- ◉ Ask immediately for a letter of intent, do not wait to long
