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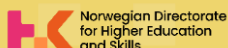
DESCRIPTION

As a result of the conference “Spreading innovative results from European University Alliances to other Higher Education Institutions” held in Bergen (Norway) on 3-5 May, 2023 the four organising National Agencies Austria (OeAD), Germany (DAAD), Hungary (Tempus Public Foundation) and Norway (HK-dir) have made joint efforts to convert the TCA into a LTA (a long-term activity) in order to continue cooperation concerning this topic. This step will provide all NA's with a number of new possibilities to arrange cooperation activities for the benefit of a broad range of stakeholders.
