Austrian NAs activities for EUI - Examples

- Active roles in events for Alliances organised by the Federal Ministry of Education Science and Research
- Attending events of Alliances in Austria to support and accompany the involved HEIs
- It is planned to integrate the topic EUIs in the ECHE monitoring concept (e.g. synergies between KA131 and mobilities within the alliances etc.)

DZS | CZELO and its activities linked to EUI

For now, we support mostly the Czech HEIs involved in the EUI:

- A community of good practice to exchange practices and articulate their needs towards us as the NA, the relevant ministeries and National Accreditation Bureau:
- ✓ shared Teams
- ✓ online meetings every 2 months
- ✓ two-day workshop for administrators once a year
- ✓ roundtable for HEIs´ management, MEYS and National Accreditation Bureau once a year (as part of CZEDUCON preconference)



- ✓ Factsheets on Czech HEIs involved in EUI updated after the call 2024, 3 new CZ HEIs, now: 12 in total (almost 50% of all CZ public HEIs)
- ✓ Sessions on European University Alliances at CZEDUCON (sharing of good practice, presentations of alliances´ outcomes and findings to the other HEIs)

In focus: Engaging in Public relations/Providing a "look behind the scenes"

- Regular publications via the DAAD communication channels, e.g. thematic articles, press releases, podcast "Campus Europa" (2020 -2022) (in German)
- Upload of various information on the EUI on the <u>programme website</u>, e.g. German EUNN contact list, <u>project map</u>, event documentation, <u>short movies</u> (in German and partly English)
- Yearly launch of the "Week of the European Universities Alliances" (around Europe Day)
 under the patronage of the Federal Education Minister: various events and activities
 organised by the EUN-HEI accompanied by a DAAD social media campaign, website and
 press release (in German, since 2022)
- Funding of communication measures implemented by German HEI in EUN, e.g. podcasts, social media and communication campaigns



In focus: Supporting exchange between EUN and the broader HE landscape

- Active involvement of EUN representatives in established DAAD event/dialogue formats and international conferences such as EAIE (sessions and/or poster presentation)
- For Seal of Excellence holders:
 - Invitation to participate in the so called "EUN Forum", an informal virtual exchange format (every 6-8 weeks) for EUN colleagues at German HEIs
 - Distribution of factsheets on regulatory hurdles to European university cooperation on the national level. These documents were prepared and are regularly updated by a working group of the vice-presidents of the German HEI presented in EUN and are intended to support the HEI in their work to remove administrative and regulatory hurdles.
 - Invitation to join a mailing list for EUN project representatives at German HEI

What's new regarding the Icelandic NA's activities for EUI

- Ministry has funding to support cooperation between universities in Iceland, alliance members received funding for a national forum which has met four times since 2023.
- First high-level meeting on September 11 with representatives from the Ministry, Swedish NA, and universities from the four alliance.
- Need for a national internationalization strategy and funding models aligned with EUI objectives, plus stronger Brussels representation. The forum will formulate proposals on improving national funding models.
- Inclusive approach emphasized, next meeting taking place on November 1, open to all Icelandic universities as observers
- New <u>EUI webpage</u> launched on the NA website


