## Aspects of equity


- 1. Equitable Opportunity: Ensuring that all individuals have equitable opportunities to succeed, regardless of their race, gender, socioeconomic status, disability, or other personal characteristics.
- 2. Reducing Disparities: Identifying and addressing systemic inequalities and disparities that exist within a society to create a more level playing field for all.
- Fairness: Treating individuals justly and impartially, taking into account their unique needs and circumstances, and providing additional support to those who have been historically disadvantaged.
- 4. Inclusivity: Embracing diversity and accommodating various backgrounds, identities, and abilities to ensure that everyone can fully participate and benefit from society's resources and opportunities.
- 5. Social Justice: Pursuing policies and practices that seek to rectify past and ongoing injustices and promote a more equitable and just society.
