
Remaining opportunities to collaborate with UK higher education organisations

Closing Erasmus+ 2014-2020

- All ongoing Erasmus+ activities financed through the 2014-2020 Multi Annual Financial Framework can continue as planned until their completion.
- This applies to all Erasmus+ projects in the wider education, training and youth sectors, involving partnership with other European or with non-European organisations.



International dimension of Erasmus+ 2021-2027



Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters (EMJM)

- Excellent integrated Master courses offered by consortia of 3+ full partner HEIs from three different countries, of which at least two must be EU Member States or Associated third countries
- Attract best students worldwide through EU-funded scholarships
- Duration: 6 academic years covering at least 4 editions of the master programme
- 1 to 2 academic years (60, 90 or 120 ECTS credits) with study in 2+ countries, of which at least one must be an EU MS or Associated third country
- Institutions from **all over the world** may submit a proposal on behalf of an international consortium

Erasmus Mundus Design Measures (EMDM)



- New sub-action, supporting the design of high-level study programmes at master level
- An EM Design Measures project involves at least 3 full partner HEIs from three different countries, of which at least two must be EU Member States or Associated third countries
- Independent call for proposals
- Fixed duration of 15 months
- Institutions from all over the world may submit a proposal on behalf of an international consortium
- single lump sum contribution of 55.000 Euros



Partial opening of Higher education mobility projects

General principle

Up to 20% of funds awarded to each project can be used to fund outgoing mobility of students and staff

from the higher education institutions located in Programme Countries to any Partner Countries in the world

Conditions:

- with several Partner Countries
- cover the widest possible geographical scope.

Applies also in **the VET field** for accredited organisations in Programme Countries

- Student mobility for studies
- Student mobility for traineeships
- Staff mobility for teaching
- Staff mobility for training
- Blended intensive programmes
