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

# What are the most urgent challenges that need to be tackled on the topics of digitalization and internationalization?

Professional support for smaller institutions, funding for technical resources

Inclusiveness of these new opportunities (digital mobility/blended learning)

Securing our students - the future citizens of Europe - are equipped, not only technical but also ethical. They have to understand the power of programming - real life consequences from our digital life

Go for high quality innovative projects not replicate existing
