# ERASMUS

**ERASMUS+** has been one of the most successful EU initiatives since 1987. No other programme reaches its scale, with hundreds of thousands of grants delivered per year. 59.8% of participants in student mobility between 2014 and 2018 would not have gone on ERASMUS+ mobility without an ERASMUS+ grant (EC Data). Since the basis of grant calculation has basically remained the same at least since 2014, we have to ask:

## **INCLUSION IN ERASMUS+**

#### SINCE 2021...

- New and more flexible forms of mobility
- 7 countries increased ERASMUS+ grant levels

#### BUT...

- In recent years, grant amounts were dramatically different from country to country, sometimes discouraging the participation of students
- Over 50% of students participating in intra-European mobility can **cover less** than 50% of their expenses with their grant [in: ESNsurvey - XIV Edition: "Understanding the experiences and needs of exchange students in challenging times"]
- Only 10% of the mobile learners benefited from top-up for fewer opportunities in 2021 [in: Erasmus+ Annual Report 2021]

• The mobility scholarship and how it varies influence the choices concerning destination and duration of mobility • If financial worries were lessened or

**removed** entirely by the grant, then the mobility itself would be a more enriching academic and personal experience

• A scholarship with rates that are adjusted to the actual costs of a mobility would provide the opportunity for more students to take part in it. The idea of a grant indexed to regional costs of living was very popular among students

Sustainable travel ticket to go and return from mobility • A way to reduce the CO2 footprint of the programme while encouraging students to discover Europe

Cost of living CALCULATOR available for HEIs, a simple way for IROs to calculate and communicate the grant amount
