1. Inclusion service:

Any student who has special needs due to a disease, a disability or a special learning disability can ask for adjustments and special support to our 100% dedicated inclusion service.

We pay close attention to all the students with special needs, as stated in the Inclusive Higher Education decree which was passed by the Wallonia-Brussels Federation Parliament in January 2014. Some facilities are applied to all these students with special needs, our students as well as the Incoming students from our partners.

2. Specific application form:

The application form filled in by students to get an Erasmus grant and/or to apply for an Erasmus stay at HEAJ has a special section dedicated to inclusivity.

If this section is ticked, then the student has to fill in a specific form to describe his/her disability and needs. This form is collected and sent to our partner's dedicated service where the adjustments are made.
