Capacity Building in Higher Education (CBHE)

- Multilateral partnerships of HEIs from Europe (27 EU-Member States or countries associated to Erasmus+) and eligible countries worldwide (third countries not associated to Erasmus+)
- **Applicant** organisation can come from Europe or eligible countries worldwide (e.g. Sub-Saharan Africa)
- The CBHE action supports the relevance, quality, modernisation and responsiveness of Higher Education Institutions and systems in third countries (not associated to the Erasmus+ Programme) for socio-economic recovery, growth and prosperity.
- In focus: needs of the third countries not associated to Erasmus+
- EU member states and third countries associated to the Programme: do not introduce novelties to their countries, but act as transferers of knowledge and practices


Capacity Building in Higher Education (CBHE)

Objectives of the Action:

- Improve the quality of higher education in third countries not associated to E+ (Modernisation)
- Innovate teaching and learning (Innovation)
- increase skills and employability of students
- improve quality assurance and management in HEIs (Governance)
- make higher education more relevant for the labour market and society (Societal impact)
- Foster Cooperation and Regional Integration

CBHE – Three strands

- Strand 1: Fostering access to cooperation in Higher Education for less experienced HEIs and newcomers
 - 24 or 36 months, between **200.000 and 400.000 Euro** per project
- Strand 2 Partnerships for transformation with an impact on innovation, university/business relations and institutional governance (change at institutional level)
 24 or 36 months, between 400.000 and 800.000 Euro per project
- Strand 3 Structural reform projects with involvement of ministries
 36 or 48 months, between 600.000 and 1.000.000 Euro per project (impact at system level)

Budget can cover staff costs, travel and subsistence costs, equipment costs and subcontracting as well as other costs (such as dissemination of information, publishing or translation)

Consortium structure: At least 2 HEIs from two EU Member States or third countries associated to Erasmus+ **and** 2 HEIs from each eligible third country not associated to Erasmus+

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Capacity Building in Vocational Education and Training (CBVET)

- international cooperation projects based on **multilateral partnerships** between organisations active in the field of VET in EU Member States and third countries associated to the Programme, and third countries not associated to the Programme (e.g. Sub-Saharan Africa).
- this action intends to increase the capacity of VET providers (in third countries not associated to the Erasmus+ Programme) - especially in the fields of management, governance, inclusion, quality assurance, and innovation – and to strengthen the link between VET providers and the labour market
- Institutions from Africa can be <u>partners</u> in projects (not applicants/coordinators)
- Thematic areas like: Work-based learning, VET teachers/trainers professional development, Innovation in VET etc. (see Programme Guide)
- EU grant per project: 100.000 400.000 €
- Duration of project: 12, 24 or 36 months
