

WORLDWIDE MOBILITY BETWEEN PROGRAMME COUNTRIES AND PARTNER COUNTRIES


Programme Countries: 27 EU states + Iceland, Liechtenstein, Macedonia, Norway, Serbia, Turkey



ONLY German institutions can apply on behalf of all involved partners.




