# Zu den „Objectives“

Objectives of the proposed project are to

- create substantiated interest of relevant private and public practitioners with different backgrounds (police, risk and security experts, trade specialists, psychologists and legal professionals) in the EU and the relevance of its political, legal and economy-related measures
- foster inter- and multidisciplinary specialist knowledge on EU policy areas into ten study programmes and numerous life-long learning activities not yet related to EU studies and into the CONRIS network partner institutions' curricula
- provide tailored courses on specific EU issues relevant for participants in their respective professional life at public and private level, including the civil society sector
- provide opportunities for first teaching experiences for young researchers and scholars and practitioners in European issues
- contribute to foster the publication and dissemination of results of academic research within the framework of projects implemented by NBS
- interlink existing JM programme initiatives and results with present project to show to Module participants the broader range of the JM activities.

Erasmus+ supports Jean Monnet Modules with the aim to:

- promote research and first teaching experience for young researchers and scholars and practitioners in EU issues: **1 Person (f) im JMM-Team; 3 andere sind “seniors” (m)**
- foster the publication and dissemination of the results of academic research: **2 Journal Articles, 1 Buch, 3 Websites, Aufzeichnung der Lehrveranstaltungen und Bereitstellung auf Youtube o.ä.**
- create interest in the EU and constitute the basis for future poles of European knowledge, particularly in Partner Countries: **JMM geöffnet für alle Interessierten**
- foster the introduction of a European Union angle into mainly non EU related studies: **Dies war im Antrag darzustellen durch Abgleich mit den existierenden Curricula der NBS**
- deliver tailor-made courses on specific EU issues relevant for graduates in their professional life: **NBS ist stark im Bereich “Unternehmenssicherheit”; folglich haben wir hier aufgesattelt mit allem, was zur EU Security Union gehört**
